



## Red and white Rose Basket

Fabrics are from A Red Rose by Fabric Freedom

Please read through all the instructions before you begin, press each seam after sewing to achieve the best finish to your work.

### Requirements

| 1. Large bright red roses F678 col.1         | - $\frac{3}{8}$ yard - 30cm            |
| 2. Red standing roses on white F679 col.2    | - fat $\frac{1}{4}$                    |
| 3. Medium bright red close roses F680 col.2  | - $\frac{5}{8}$ yard - 60cm            |
| 4. Spaced rose heads on white F681 col.1     | - $\frac{3}{8}$ yard - 30cm            |
| 5. Small roses black dot on white F682 col.1 | - $\frac{5}{8}$ yard - 60cm            |
| 6. Bright red geometric F684 col.11          | - $\frac{5}{8}$ yard - 60cm            |
| 7. White fabric                              | - $\frac{1}{2}$ yard - $\frac{1}{2}$ m |

Wadding and backing 45" x 45"

### Cutting

Refer to diagrams below for 45° angle cuts on pieces from fabrics 1, 4 and 5.

From fabric 1 cut

- 1 x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " square, cut in half diagonally twice
- 4 x 3 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, cut 45° angles from top left and right

From fabric 2 cut

- 3 x 8" x 8" squares, cut in half diagonally once

From fabric 3 cut

- 3 x 8" x 8" squares, cut in half diagonally once
- 2 x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 39 $\frac{1}{4}$ " strips - outer border
- 2 x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 41 $\frac{1}{4}$ " strips - outer border

From fabric 4 cut

- 20 x 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ " squares, cut in half diagonally once
- 5 x 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares
- 4 x 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 13 $\frac{7}{8}$ " strips, cut 45° angles from top left and right

4 x  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $6\frac{7}{8}$ " strips, cut  $45^\circ$  angles from top left and right  
4 x  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $4\frac{3}{8}$ " strips, cut a  $45^\circ$  angle from top right  
4 x  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{8}$ " strips, cut a  $45^\circ$  angle from top left

From fabric 5 cut

4 x  $2\frac{5}{8}$ " x  $18\frac{1}{8}$ " strips, cut  $45^\circ$  angles from top left and right  
2 x  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares, cut in half diagonally once  
4 x  $2\frac{5}{8}$ " x  $9\frac{3}{8}$ " strips, cut a  $45^\circ$  angle from top right  
4 x  $2\frac{5}{8}$ " x  $7\frac{1}{4}$ " strips, cut a  $45^\circ$  angle from top left

From fabric 6 cut

16 x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " strips  
2 x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $37\frac{1}{4}$ " strips – inner border  
2 x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $39\frac{1}{4}$ " strips – inner border

From fabric 7 cut


2 x  $2\frac{5}{8}$ " x  $2\frac{5}{8}$ " squares, cut in half diagonally twice  
4 x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares  
3 x  $5\frac{5}{8}$ " x  $5\frac{5}{8}$ " squares cut in half diagonally once  
10 x  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $7\frac{3}{4}$ " strips  
15 x  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " squares, cut in half diagonally once



cut a  $45^\circ$  angles from top right and left corners



cut a  $45^\circ$  angle from top right corner




cut a  $45^\circ$  angle from top left corner

## Making

1. Using diagram 1 as a guide lay out all of the fabric pieces needed to make the rose basket blocks.
2. Stitch together the two large triangles from fabrics 2 and 3 to make the centre square of the block. When turned on point, fabric 2 will be the top half of the square.
3. Stitch small triangles from fabrics 4 and 7 together in pairs to make six squares.
4. Stitch these squares together into two rows of three and then stitch the small square from fabric 4 to the end of one of the strips. This is now a set of four squares.
5. Turn the centre square on point and stitch the set of three squares to the top right of the centre square and the set of four squares to the top left of the centre square.
6. Next stitch a small triangle from fabric 4 to the short right hand end of a fabric 7 rectangle and stitch another small triangle to the short left hand end of a second rectangle.
7. Stitch these pieces to the lower left and right sides of the centre square.

8. Finally stitch the corner triangle in place to complete the block. Make another four in the same way.
9. Using diagram 2 as a guide lay out all of the pieces needed for the side inset pieces.
10. Begin with the small triangle and stitch the pieces together in sequence to make a large triangle. This completes the piece, now make another three in the same way.
11. Using diagram 3 lay out all of the pieces needed for the corner triangles.
12. Begin with the small triangle and stitch the smaller of the fabric 4 strips to the top left of the triangle and then stitch the longer of the fabric 4 strips to the top right of the triangle, this will make a larger triangle.
13. Next stitch the shorter of the fabric 5 strips to the top right of the triangle and the longer of the fabric 5 strips to the top left of the triangle. This completes the piece, now make another three in the same way.
14. To complete the quilt top lay out all of the blocks, inset pieces and corner pieces as shown in the main diagram and place the sashing pieces where required, ready to be made up.
15. Beginning at the bottom left hand corner, make up the sashing strip and stitch to the corner triangle. Continue working diagonally across the quilt until all the pieces and blocks have been stitched.
16. Add the borders, side pieces first and then the top and bottom pieces.
17. Layer together the top, wadding and backing fabric and pin or baste in place.
18. Quilt a pleasing design either by hand or machine.
19. Add the binding to complete the project.

Diagram 1- Rose Basket Block - Make 5




Diagram 2 – Side Inset Piece – Make 4




Diagram 3 – Corner Piece – Make 4
