



Stained Glass Robin and Stars Cushion

Fabrics are from Glass Robins and Stars by Fabric Freedom

Please read through all the instructions before you begin.

Requirements

1. F793-3 - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
2. F794-3 - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
3. F792-2 - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
4. F745-21 - fat $\frac{1}{8}$
5. F745-20 - fat $\frac{1}{8}$
6. H50-14 - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
7. H50-53 - fat $\frac{1}{4}$

Wadding and backing for two cushions

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

2 x 6 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 6 $\frac{3}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally once
1 x 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ "

From fabric 2 cut

4 x 2" x 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

From fabric 3 cut

1 x 7" x 7" cut in half diagonally twice
4 x 2" x 2"

From fabric 4 cut

2 x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " cut in half diagonally once

From fabric 5 cut

1 x 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice

From fabric 6 cut

2 x 1" x 17½"

2 x 1" x 18½"

From fabric 7 cut

4 x ⅞" x 4½" cut a 45° at each end * see diagram below

4 x ⅞" x 5¾" cut a 45° at each end * see diagram below

4 x ⅞" x 7¾" cut a 45° at each end * see diagram below

4 x ⅞" x 10¾" cut a 45° at each end * see diagram below

4 x 1" x 2"

2 x 1" x 13½"

2 x 1" x 17½"



cut 45° angles from top right and left corners

Sewing

Remember to press each seam after sewing to achieve a crisp, professional finish to your work.


1. Lay out all the pieces stacked and sorted ready for use.
2. Beginning with the centre square, stitch a black sashing strip to each side.
3. Next stitch the small red triangles in place and add another set of sashing strips.
4. Continue working in this way until all four sets of triangles have been used. This completes the cushion centre.
5. To make the borders first stitch a sashing strip to the left and right sides of the cushion centre.
6. Add the side border pieces.
7. Stitch the long sashing strips to the top and bottom edges of the cushion centre.
8. To make up the top and bottom borders stitch a small sashing strip and a small square to each end of the long border pieces.
9. Stitch the top and bottom borders in place.
10. Lastly add the outer border strips, side pieces first then the top and bottom pieces.
11. Lay the cushion top onto the wadding and baste in place.
12. Quilt by hand or machine.
13. Add an envelope backing to complete the cushion cover.

Envelope back for cushion

Cut two pieces of fabric the width of the cushion front x $\frac{2}{3}$ of the length. For example, an 18" cushion would need two pieces 18" x 12".

1. Turn in and hem one long edge on each piece.
2. Place the cushion front face up on your work table.
3. Place one piece of the backing fabric face down on top of the cushion front matching top and side edges.
4. Place the second piece of backing fabric face down on the cushion front matching bottom and side edges.
5. Pin in place and stitch all round.
6. Turn right side out.
