





Quilt Size: 68" x 88"

Mosaic Star Block Size: 16" x 16"

Fabric A 2 yards J-8670-158 (borders)

Cut (8) 8-1/2" width of fabric (WOF) strips, sew together end-to-end then cut (2) side borders 8-1/2" x 72-1/2" and (2) top/bottom 8-1/2" x 68-1/2" borders

Fabric B 1-3/4 yards J-8671-158 (blocks, pieced borders)

Cut (3) 8-1/2" x wof strips, from these strips cut: (12) 8-1/2" squares; from remaining end of each of these strips, cut (2) 5-1/4" squares then cut the squares in half on diagonal twice to make (8) quarter-square triangles

Cut (1) 8-1/4" x wof strip, from this strip cut (3) 8-1/4" squares, then cut the squares in half on the diagonal twice to make (12) quarter-square triangles

Cut (3) 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips, from these strips cut: (12) 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

Cut (2) 4-1/2" x wof strip, from this strip cut (12) 4-1/2" squares

Cut (1) 4-7/8" x wof strip, recut into (6) 4-7/8" squares

Fabric C* 3/4 yard J-8672-158 (blocks, border cornerstones)

Cut (3) 8-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (9) 8-1/2" squares

Fabric D 2/3 yard J-8674-134 (pieced sashings)

Cut (2) 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" wof strips, recut into (8) 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

Cut (1) 4-1/2" x wof strip, recut into (8) 4-1/2" squares

Cut (2) (1) 5-1/4" x wof strip, recut into (2) 5-1/4" squares, then cut each square in half on diagonal twice to make (8) quarter-square triangles

Fabric E 1-3/4 yds J-8675-158 (blocks, pieced sashings)

Cut (4) 4-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (16) 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

Cut (1) 8-1/4" x wof strip, recut into (2) 8-1/4" squares, then cut each square in half on the diagonal twice to make (8) quarter-square triangles

Cut (6) 4-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (52) 4-1/2" squares

Cut (1) 4-7/8" x wof strip, recut into (6) 4-7/8" squares

Fabric F 1/8 yard J-8674-158 (pieced sashings)

Cut (1) 3-3/8" x wof strip, recut into (8) 3-3/8" squares

Fabric G 1-1/4 yards J-8673-158 (blocks, cornerstones)

Cut (4) 4-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (36) 4-1/2" squares

Cut (8) 2-1/4" x wof strips, sew together end-to-end for binding

Fabric H 1-1/4 yards J-9000 mint pearl (blocks, sashings)
Cut (4) 4-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (32) 4-1/2" squares
Cut (5) 2-1/2" x wof strips, sew together end-to-end then cut (4) 2-1/2" x 48-1/2"
top/bottom sashings
Cut (4) 2-1/2" x wof strips, sew together end-to-end, cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 72-1/2" side
sashings

Fabric I 3/4 yard J-9000 pink pearl (pieced sashings, pieced borders)
Cut (5) 4-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (40) 4-1/2" squares


***Backing** 5 yards J-8672-158
Cut into (2) equal pieces, sew together selvedge to selvedge for backing

Making the Quilt


Note: Carefully refer to each of the diagrams with each sewing step to make the blocks and assemble the quilt. Press all seams as you sew.

1. **Star block corners:** Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (6) 4-7/8" fabric E squares. Position a 4-7/8" fabric E square and a same size fabric B square with right sides together. Sew 1/4" on each side of the drawn line (see diagram 1). Cut apart on the line, fold out fabric B triangles and press seam to yield 12 half-square triangles for block corners.
2. **Flying geese units:** Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (32) 4-1/2" fabric H 4-1/2" squares. Position a fabric H square at one end of a 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" fabric E rectangle, stitch on the drawn line. Trim excess fabric 1/4" from stitching line, fold out triangle and press. Make 32 units. Repeat with (4) 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" fabric E rectangles and (8) fabric 4-1/2" B squares; (4) 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" fabric D rectangles paired with (16) 4-1/2" fabric I squares; (8) 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" fabric B rectangles and (16) 4-1/2" fabric I squares.
3. **Square-in-a-square units:** Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (48) 4-1/2" fabric E squares. Position a fabric E square in opposite corners of an 8-1/2" fabric B square. Sew on the drawn line, trim 1/4" from stitch line and fold out triangles. Repeat in remaining corners (see diagram 3). Make 12. Repeat with (36) 4-1/2" fabric G squares and (9) 8-1/2" fabric D squares.
4. **Star block assembly:** Join a E/H flying geese unit to opposite sides of a square-in-a-square unit. Join a B/E half-square triangle unit to opposite sides of one of the two remaining E/H flying geese units carefully watching orientation of the triangles. Join an additional B/E half-square triangle to one side of the remaining E/H flying geese unit and a 4-1/2" E square to the other side. Sew these units to the top and bottom of the block center to complete the block.


5. **Pieced sashings:** Refer to the diagram to make the pieced sashing units. Join a 5-1/4" fabric B quarter-square triangle to two adjacent side of a 3-3/8" fabric F square. Make 4. Join a 5-1/4" fabric E 5-1/4" quarter-square triangle to two adjacent side of a fabric F 3-3/8" square. Make 4. Using the (4) D/I flying geese units and the (4) B/E flying geese units and (8) fabric E 8-1/4" quarter square triangles piece the sashing unit together. Make 4.
6. **Pieced borders:** Make 4 pieced border rows joining 4-1/2" I square to each end of a B/I flying geese unit. Make 8. Join these units to each side of a D/I flying geese unit to make a pieced border row. Make 4. Join a border row to opposite sides of the quilt center. Join a fabric B 4-1/2" square to each end of the remaining (2) flying geese rows and join to the top/bottom of the quilt center.
7. **Square-in-a-square borders:** Sew (6) of the B/E square-in-a-square units made in step 3 into a row to make a border row. Make 2 rows.
8. **Sashings:** Join a fabric H 2-1/2" x 48-1/2" sashing strip to each long side of the 2 pieced square-in-a-square border rows made in step 7. Join these border rows to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Join a 2-1/2" x 72-1/2" sashing strips to opposite sides of the quilt center.
9. **Borders:** Join the fabric A 8-1/2" x 72-1/2" borders to opposite sides of the quilt top. Join the fabric A 8-1/2" x 68-1/2" to the top/bottom to complete the quilt.
10. **Finishing:** Layer the quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt the layers together. Bind the edges to finish.




Flying Geese Assembly Diagram




Square-in-a-Square Assembly Diagram
