

Materials

Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
CX6004 Jewel Purses Galore	1/3 yard	Cut 2 strips 5 1/2" x width of the fabric Cut into 8 - 5 1/2" x 7 1/2" rectangles
CX5951 Jewel 20/20	1/3 yard	Cut 2 strips 5 1/2" x width of the fabric Cut into 8 - 5 1/2" x 7 1/2" rectangles
CX6006 Navy Don't Be a Square	1 yard	Cut 4 strips 1 1/2" x width of the fabric Cut 4 strips 4 1/2" x width of the fabric Cut 4 strips 2 1/2" x width of the fabric - for binding
CX6016 Jewel Patchwork Too	1 1/4 yards	Backing
CX1492 Passion Ta Dot	1/4 yard	Cut 2 strips 2 1/2" x width of the fabric Cut into 28 - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares
SC5333 Raspberry Cotton Couture	1/3 yard	Cut 6 - strips 1 1/2" x width of the fabric
SC5333 Tangerine Cotton Couture	1/8 yard	Cut 4 - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares

Disclaimers

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting, and or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

DIRECTIONS:

CONSTRUCTION: 1/4" seam allowance

Sew block together as shown in the photo.

Start sewing at the arrow and sew square to the purple rectangle - stop stitching 1/4" before the end. Next sew the eyeglass rectangle (on the right) and continue adding the pieces all around the block.

Repeat three times.

Sew the four blocks together. Press.

Sew 1 1/2" RASPBERRY strips to the top and bottom - 24 1/2" long. Press.

Sew 1 1/2" RASPBERRY strips to the sides of the quilt - 26 1/2" long. Press.

Sew two strips together lengthwise - 1 1/2" RASPBERRY and 1 1/2" NAVY. Press.

Cut into 2 1/2" squares. Repeat to get a total of 28 squares.

Alternate the above squares with the PASSION squares.

Stitch 4 rows with the RASP/NAVY square horizontally - NAVY on the top.

Rows for the top and bottom of the quilt will have 7 RASP/NAVY squares and 6 PASSION squares. Accurate 1/4" seams are a must. Press these two rows and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press.

Rows for the sides of the quilt will have 8 PASSION squares and 7 RASP/NAVY squares. Press. Sew to the sides of the quilt. Press.

Sew final borders to the top and bottom of the quilt: top and bottom - 30 1/2" x 4 1/2", sides - 38 1/2" x 4 1/2".

One piece of fabric will provide the backing of the quilt.

One piece of fabric is used for the quilt backing.

I machine quilted this quilt from the back side - following the lines of the hexagon fabric. Really fun!!

The four -2 1/2" strips of binding are sewn together and sewn on as French Fold Binding.
