**Fabric Requirements:**

- A. Pattern #23843-Red1.....1/3 yard
- B. Pattern #23844-Red1.....1 yard
- C. Pattern #23846-Mul1.....1/2 yard
- D. Pattern #23848-Red1.....3/8 yard
- E. Pattern #23849-Red1.....3/8 yard
- F. Pattern #23849-Gre1.....1 yard
- G. Pattern #23850-Gre1.....3/8 yard
- H. Pattern #23845-Red 1.....1 1/4 yard
- Batting.....1 piece 40" x 40"

**Cutting Instructions:**

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. All seams are a scant 1/4" which is included in all measurements unless otherwise stated. Cut pieces in order listed. Label all pieces. Refer to all illustrations and the quilt image for proper cutting and assembly. \* wof = width of fabric, lof = length of fabric. It is strongly recommended to heavily starch all pieces making any bias cuts.

**Fabric A – Santa Patch (23843-Red1)**

1. Fussy cut two of each patch 6" x 6" and label as follows:

**Fabric B –Santa Shelf (23844-Red1)**

1. Fussy cut four strips 2 7/8" x wof. Begin cutting 1/4" below the Santa oval stripe and ending 1/2" above the same Santa oval stripe. Label: "Border 4".



**Fabric C – Santa Scenic (23846-Mul1)**

1. Fussy cut one block 6" x 6", centering the Santa figure. Label: "Block 14".
2. Fussy cut four squares, on point to measure 4 3/8" x 4 3/8", centering the deer. Label: "C".

**Fabric D –Tossed Toys (23848-Red1)**

1. Cut eight squares 4 3/8" x 4 3/8". Label: "A".

**Fabric E – Tonal Stars, red (23849-Red1)**

1. Cut four strips 1" x wof. Label: "Border 1".
2. Cut ten squares 4" x 4", then cut each square in half, on the diagonal, to make a total of twenty triangles. Label: "B".

**Fabric F –Tonal Stars, green (23849-Gre1)**

1. Cut four strips 3" x wof for the binding.
2. Cut four strips 1" x wof. Label: "Border 3".
3. Cut four squares 4 3/8" x 4 3/8". Label: "D".
4. Cut eighteen squares 4" x 4", then cut each square in half on the diagonal to make a total of thirty six triangles. Label: "E".

**Fabric G – Plaid (23850-Gre1)**

1. Cut four strips 1 1/2" x wof. Label: "Border 2".
2. Cut four squares 4" x 4", then cut each square in half on the diagonal to make a total of eight triangles. Label: "F".

**Fabric H – Santa Patchwork (23845-Red1)**


1. Cut one piece to measure 40" x 40" for the backing.

**Piecing Instructions:**

\*Please refer to the quilt image to accurately arrange the pieces for each block. Because of the directionality of the fabric, it is necessary to carefully check the orientation of each piece before sewing in place.

**Block 5:**

1. Center and sew the long side of a "B" piece to opposite sides of an "A".



2. Center and sew a "B" piece to the remaining two sides of "A".



3. Square up block to 6".
4. Repeat for a total of eight blocks, and label: "Block 5".

**Block 6:**

1. Center and sew a "B" piece to the upper left side of a "C" piece. Center and sew an "E" piece to opposite edge (lower right edge) of "C".



2. Center and sew a "B" piece to the remaining two sides of "C".



3. Square up block to 6".
4. Label: "Block 6".

**Blocks 7, 8, and 9:**

Repeat the steps for "Block 6" rotating the position of "E" and labeling the blocks as indicated by the illustrations below.

**Block 10:**

1. Center and sew an "F" piece to the upper left side of "D". Center and sew a "B" piece to the opposite side (lower right) of "D".



2. Center and sew an "F" piece to the upper right side of "D". Center and sew a "B" piece to the opposite side (lower left) of "D".



3. Square up block to 6".
4. Label "Block 10".

**Blocks 11, 12, And 13:**

Repeat the steps for "Block 10" to make a total of four blocks. Rotate the positions of "B" and "F" and label the blocks as seen below.



### Quilt Assembly:

Refer to the quilt image as well as the illustration below to properly arrange and align the blocks.

1. Lay out the blocks as in the illustration below.
2. Sew the blocks in rows, then sew the rows together.



### Borders:

The quilt has a total of four borders. Follow the steps below to attach Borders 1, 2 and 3.

#### Borders 1, 2, and 3:

1. Measure the quilt top through the center from top to bottom (north to south).
2. Cut two of the "Border 1" strips to this measurement.
3. Sew one of these strips to each side edge of the quilt top.
4. Measure the quilt top from side to side (east to west) including the borders.
5. Cut the remaining two "Border 1" strips to this measurement.
6. Sew one of these strips to the top edge and one to the bottom edge of the quilt top.
7. Measure and attach "Border 2" and "Border 3" to the quilt top as you did with "Border 1".

#### Border 4:

1. Center and pin in place, one of the "Border 4" strips on one edge of the quilt top, making sure that the Santa ovals face in towards the quilt top.
2. Sew in place, beginning and ending 1/4" from each end of the quilt top. DO NOT trim the excess fabric.
3. Repeat on the remaining sides.
4. Miter the corners, and trim away the excess fabric to complete the quilt top.

#### Finishing:

1. Layer the quilt top with the batting and backing and quilt as desired.
2. Trim the backing and batting 1/4" **past** the quilt top.
3. Sew the binding strips end to end with a diagonal seam to form one long strip.
4. Press the strip in half, lengthwise, wrong sides together.
5. Sew to the quilt front, matching the raw edges of the binding with the edge of the batting (**not** the quilt top), with a **1/2"** seam allowance, mitering the corners.
6. Turn the binding to the back and stitch in place.
