

Christmas Eve Quilt

Skill Level: Beginner

CUTTING

WOF = Width of Fabric

45288 F - Cut the panel to 31 ½" x 42 ½"

45290 R - Cut the following strips from the **length** of the fabric:

2 strips @ 5 ½" x 44 ½"

2 strips @ 5 ½" x 52 ½"

From remaining fabric cut 4 squares @ 5 ½" x 5 ½"

45294 AG - cut the following strips from the **length** of the fabric;

2 strips @ 2 ½" x 58 ½"

2 strips @ 2 ½" x 52 ½"

From remaining fabric cut 4 rectangles @ 2 ½" x 5 ½"

From the remaining length of the fabric, cut 5 strips @ 2¼" x the length (binding)

45295 F - Cut 2 strips @ 5 ¼" x WOF; sub cut 10 squares @ 5 ¼" x 5 ¼", cut twice diagonally (40 triangles)

Cut 3 strips @ 2½" x WOF; join these together with diagonal seams; sub cut 2 @ 2 ½" x 43 ½"

Cut 2 strips @ 1" x WOF; sub cut 2 @ 1" x 36 ½"

Cut 1 strip @ 2 ½" x WOF; sub cut 8 squares @ 2 ½" x 2 ½"

45295 R - Cut 2 strips @ 5 ¼" x WOF; sub cut 10 squares @ 5 ¼" x 5 ¼", cut twice diagonally (40 triangles)

45295 E - Cut 3 strips @ 5 ¼" x WOF; sub cut 20 squares @ 5 ¼" x 5 ¼", cut twice diagonally (80 triangles)

Cut 1 strip @ 2 ½" x WOF; sub cut 8 squares @ 2 ½" x 2 ½"

Cut 5 strips @ 1" x WOF; join these together with diagonal seams; sub cut 2 strips @ 1" x 42 ½", from the 2 remaining strips cut strips 2 @ 1" x 32 ½"

Assemble the quilt center

1. Sew a 1" x 42 ½" Cream tonal strip to the side edges of the panel. Press towards the panel.

2. Sew a 1" x 32 ½" Cream tonal strip to the top and bottom edges of the panel. Press towards the panel.

3. Sew a 2 ½" x 43 ½" Green tonal strip to the side edges of the panel and Cream tonal border. Press towards the Green tonal Strip.

4. Sew a 1" x 36 ½" Green tonal strip to the top and bottom edges of the panel and Cream tonal border. Press towards the Green tonal Strip. The panel with the borders should now measure 36 ½" x 44 ½".

Add the inner pieced border

Make the quarter square triangle units

1. Lay out two cream triangles, one green and one red triangle, positioning the green and red triangles at opposite sides of the unit.

2. Sew the triangles together in pairs; press away from the cream.



3. Join the two units from step 2 together to complete a quarter square triangle unit; press towards the red and cream. The finished unit should measure 4 ½" square, including seam allowances.

4. Repeat to make a total of 40 quarter square triangle units

Make the four-patch units

1. Sew the two 2 ½" cream tonal squares and two 2 ½" green tonal squares into pairs of green and cream. With the cream squares in opposite corners, sew the two pairs together into a four-patch unit.

2. Repeat to make a total of four four-patch units.

Make the pieced border strips

1. Sew the eleven quarter square triangle units end to end, with the Green tonal triangles facing the bottom to make a side border strip; press in one direction. Repeat to make a total of two side border strips.

2. In the same manner, sew nine quarter square triangle units together. Sew a four-patch unit to each end with a Green tonal square placed toward the bottom inside edge of the strip. Repeat to make a total of two border strips, one for the top and one for the bottom.



Add the Pieced Inner Border

1. With the green triangles facing the green border, sew a side pieced border strip to each long edge of the quilt center; press toward border.
2. In the same manner, sew the top and bottom pieced border strips to the remaining two edges of the quilt center; press toward the border strip.



Make the Outer Border

1. Sew together a 2 ½" x 52 ½" Plaid Print strip and a 5 ½" x 52 ½" Poinsettia strip along their long edges to make a side border strip; press towards the Poinsettia. Repeat to make a total of two side border strips.
2. Sew a 2 ½" x 5 ½" Plaid Print rectangle to one edge of a Poinsettia 5 ½" square; press towards the Plaid Print. Repeat to make a total of two corner units.
3. Sew the long edge of a Plaid Print rectangle to each the short end of a 5 ½" x 44 ½" Poinsettia strip. Sew a 2 ½" x 58 ½" Plaid print strip to the bottom of this unit to make a top border strip.
4. Repeat steps 2 and 3 process to make a bottom border strip.

Add the Outer Border

1. Sew a side border strip to the left and right edges of the quilt center; press toward the outer border.
2. Sew the top and bottom border strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center to complete the quilt.

Finish The Quilt

1. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing and pin the layers together.
2. Join the 2¼" plaid strips together end-to-end to make binding for the quilt. Fold the binding in half, wrong sides together, and press. Sew the binding to the edges of the quilt top and blind stitch in place.
