## Needle Stars

Quilt Designed by eQuilter


813/4" x 813/4"

Please read all instructions before beginning. Pre-washing NOT recommended.

## Yardages and Cutting

WOF is $42 "$ width of fabric from selvage edge to selvage edge. Length of fabric is length of fabric, parallel to the selvage edges. Remove as little fabric as possible when removing selvages and squaring strip ends.

## 2 yards window medallion print

- Fussy-cut 4 strips $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ LOF, referring to the cover quilt for the section to center in each strip. Trim strips to $671 / 4$ " for border.


## Red medallions panel

Blue medallions panel
From each panel, cut the following:

- (6) $101 / 2$ " squares with a large medallion centered in each square.


## 1/2 yard red allover medallion print

Apply a heavy coat of spray starch to the wrong side of the yardage and press dry before cutting. Prepare a 6 1/2"-square clear template.

- Fussy-cut (4) 6 1/2" squares with a medallion centered in each.


## 3/4 yard stardust print

- 2 strips 10 7/8" x WOF; cut into (6) 10 7/8" squares. Cut each square in half diagonally to make 12 triangles.


## 3/4 yard purple swirls

3/4 yard aqua swirls
From each fabric, cut the following:

- 7 strips 3" x WOF; cut into (3) 3" x 16 1/2" strips, (6) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 151 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips, (3) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 14{ }^{\prime \prime}$ strips and (6) $3^{\prime \prime}$ x $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.


## Piecing the Units

Use a 1/4" seam allowance for all stitching. Press seams as directed.

1. Sew $3^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ black strips to opposite sides of each blue large medallion square. Press seams toward the square. Repeat with 3 " x $151 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips on the remaining sides to complete (6) $151 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 151 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ black units.
2. Repeat step 1 with 3 red large medallion squares and aqua swirls strips to make 3 aqua units. Repeat with the 3 remaining red large medallion squares and purple swirls strips to make 3 purple units.

3. Stitch a $3^{\prime \prime} \times 14$ " black strip to 1 short edge of each stardust triangle, aligning 1 end of the strip with the square corner of the triangle. Press seam toward the strip. Sew a $3^{\prime \prime} \times 161 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ black strip to the remaining short edge, aligning 1 end of the strip with the square corner of the pieced unit. Press seam toward the strip. Trim the strip ends even with the edge of the stardust triangle to complete (6) $221 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 157 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 157 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ black triangle units.


Black Triangle Unit - Make 6
4. Repeat step 3 with aqua strips to make 3 aqua triangle units and with purple strips to make 3 purple triangle units.

Purple Triangle Unit — Make 3
5. Machine-baste $1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ from the long edge of each triangle to stabilize the bias edges.
6. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ black squares.
7. Place a marked square right sides together on the top left and bottom right corners of a red allover medallion square. Sew on the lines. Trim seam allowance $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ out from the stitching. Press the black triangles open with seams toward the black. Repeat on the remaining corners of the square to complete (1) $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ corner unit, except press seams away from the black. Repeat to make 4 corner units.

## Completing the Quilt

Refer to the exploded quilt diagram on the next page throughout the following steps.

1. Arrange the black, purple and aqua units with the black, purple and aqua triangle units in 6 diagonal rows as shown. Press all seams away from the aqua and purple units Join the rows to complete the $641 / 4$ " x $641 / 4$ " quilt center. Press seams to one side.
2. Sew the $2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ WOF black strips short ends together to make a long strip. Press seams to one side. Cut into 2 strips each $821 / 4 ", 791 / 4^{\prime \prime}, 671 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ and $641 / 4^{\prime \prime}$. Stitch the $641 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ strips to opposite sides of the quilt center and the $671 / 4 "$ strips to the remaining sides. Press seams toward the strips.
3. Stitch $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 671 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ window medallion print strips to opposite sides of the quilt center. Press seams toward the strips.
4. Sew a red corner to both ends of the 2 remaining window medallion print strips. Press seams toward the strips. Stitch the pieced strips to the remaining sides of the quilt center. Press seams toward the strips.
5. Stitch the $791 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ black strips from step 2 to opposite sides of the quilt center and the $821 / 4$ " strips to the remaining sides to complete the top. Press seams toward the strips.
6. If using 42 " backing fabric, remove the selvage edges from the backing pieces. Join the pieces on the long edges with a $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance. Press seams open. Trim to make the $97^{\prime \prime}$ x 97 " backing piece.
7. Layer the quilt top with the backing and batting pieces. Quilt as desired. Trim batting and backing even with the top.
8. Join the blue allover medallion binding strips on the short ends with diagonal seams to make a long strip. Press seams in one direction. Press the strip in half along the length with wrong sides together. Bind the quilt edges using your favorite method to complete the quilt.
