

Peaceful Meadow - Scroll Quilt

Quilt Designed by Deb Mosa

Finished Quilt Approx. 49-1/2" x 52-1/2" - Finished Center Size: 16" x 19"

In the Meadow fabrics by Exclusively Quilters - Style #4100



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Fabric Requirements: Based on 42" wide fabric

One **In the Meadow** panel (#61321-9)

1/2 yard sky print (#60244-2)

1/2 yards gray wood (#61323-8)

2 yards brown wood (#61323-9)

2 yards sheep at pasture print

2 yards Wide Backing or 4 yards directional 42" wide fabric

65" x 68" quilt batting

1-1/2 yards 12" wide fusible web

1 yard 20" wide tear-away stabilizer

An added 1/8 to 1/2 yard is added to all yardages to account for shrinkage, straightening, cutting errors and prints that may require special cutting to get the best results.

You should protect your investment in time and fabric by making sample blocks before cutting into your fabric because Exclusively Quilters will take no responsibility for replacing fabrics.

Cutting Directions: All measurements based on a 1/4" seam allowance.

From the **In the Meadow** panel :

Trim large panel to 16-1/2" x 19-1/2" wide and four small panels to 9" square each

From the **gray wood**:

Cut two 1-1/2" strips the **length of fabric, parallel to the selvage** for side borders.

From remaining yardage, cut two 1-1/2" x the **remaining width of fabric** for top & bottom borders.

From the **brown wood**:

Cut four 1-1/2" strips the **length of fabric, parallel to the selvage**, for side borders

From remaining yardage cut

Six 1-1/2" x the **remaining width of fabric**. Sew six strips together end to end, then cut into four equal lengths for the top and bottom borders.

Seven 2-1/2" strips the **remaining width of fabric** for binding.

One 9" strip the remaining **length of fabric, parallel to the selvage**, subcut into two 9" X 16-1/2" rectangles for side borders.

Two 9" x the **remaining width of fabric**. Trim strips to 9" x 21-1/2" for top and bottom borders

From the **sheep at pasture print cut**:

two strips 5-1/2" the **width of fabric**

two strips 5-1/2" the **remaining length of fabric, parallel to the selvage**.

Sewing Directions:

1. Stitch 1-1/2" gray wood strips for side borders to right and left sides of large panel. Press and trim excess. Add 1-1/2" gray wood for top and bottom borders to top and bottom of large panel. Press and trim excess.

2. Stitch 9" x 16-1/2" brown wood strips for side borders to right and left sides of quilt. Stitch 9" small panel squares to both ends of each 9" x 21-1/2" brown wood borders then add to top and bottom of quilt.

3. Stitch 1-1/2" x length of fabric brown wood strips for side borders to right and left sides of quilt. Press and trim excess. Add 1-1/2" brown wood top and bottom borders strips to top and bottom of quilt. Press and trim excess.

4. Trace two large scrolls, two **reverse** large scrolls, two small scrolls, two **reverse** small scrolls, eight "A" diamonds and eight "B" diamonds on paper side of fusible web leaving about 1/2" between tracings.

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5. Roughly cut out each tracing leaving about 1/4" around each shape. Lightly press the web side of tracings to wrong side of the sky print as shown. Lightly press the "A" and "B" diamond tracings to wrong side of remaining gray wood fabric.


6. Cut out each appliqué piece along marked lines.

7. Arrange appliqués centered on brown wood borders as shown in quilt layout, with the large scrolls and large *reverse* scrolls on the top and bottom borders and the small scrolls and small *reverse* scrolls on the right and left borders.

8. Place tear-away stabilizer under appliquéd areas of quilt top (optional). Hand or machine stitch around appliqué pieces using an overcast stitch such as button-hole or satin stitch. If used, remove stabilizer.

9. Stitch 5-1/2" X WOF sheep at pasture to the top and bottom of the quilt center.

10. Stitch 5-1/2" X length of fabric sheep at pasture strips to left and right sides. Press & trim.

11. Stitch 1-1/2" X length of fabric brown wood strips to left and right sides. Press and Trim


12. Stitch 1-1/2" brown wood top and bottom border strips to top and bottom of the quilt. Press and trim.

Finishing:


1. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt or tie as desired. Carefully trim backing and batting even with quilt top.

2. Prepare binding from five 2-1/2" gray wood strips. Sew strips together into one long binding strip. Press strip in half lengthwise. Bind using your favorite method.


Quilt Layout



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


Trace template onto
