Finished Quilt Size: 58" x 66"

Number of Blocks: 4

Please read all instructions before beginning. Pre-washing recommended for hand dyes only. Pre-washing NOT recommended for other fabrics.

Yardages and Cutting

WOF is 42" width of fabric from selvage edge to selvage edge. Remove as little fabric as possible when squaring strip ends.

1 Serenity Wolf panel

- Trim to 34 1/2" wide x 42 1/2" tall.

1 1/4 yards fuchsia hand dye

- 2 strips 5 1/2" x WOF; cut into (28) 3" x 5 1/2" rectangles.
- 1 strip 3 3/8" x WOF; cut into (4) 3 3/8" squares.
- 8 strips 3" x WOF; cut into 2 each 3" x 42 1/2", 3" x 37 1/2", 3" x 34 1/2" and 3" x 29 1/2" strips; and (4) 3" x 5 1/2" rectangles.

5/8 yard purple hand dye

- 6 strips 2 1/2" x WOF for border.

5/8 yard dark amethyst hand dye

- 7 strips 2 1/4" x WOF for binding.

1 1/2 yards pink hand dye

- 1 strip 3 3/8" x WOF; cut into (4) 3 3/8" squares and (9) 3" squares.
- 13 strips 3" x WOF; cut into 2 each 3" x 42 1/2", 3" x 37 1/2", 3" x 34 1/2" and 3" x 29 1/2" strips; and (63) 3" squares.

4 1/4 yards 42" backing fabric OR

4 3/4 yards directional backing fabric

- 2 strips 73" x WOF OR
- 2 strips 81" x WOF directional backing

OR

2 1/4 yards wide backing fabric

- 1 piece 73" x 81"

Batting

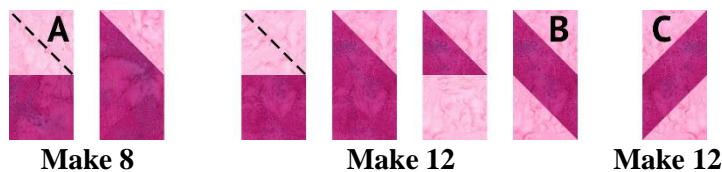
- 1 piece 73" x 81"

Piecing the Blocks & Border Units

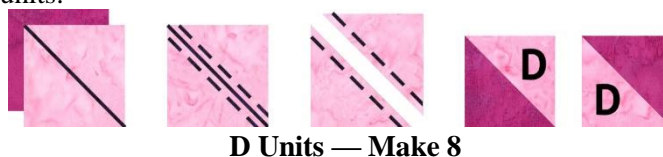
Use a 1/4" seam allowance for all stitching. Press seams as directed.

1. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each (64) 3" and all 3 3/8" pink squares.

2. Place a marked 3" pink square right sides together on 1 end of a 3" x 5 1/2" fuchsia rectangle. Sew on the line. Trim seam allowance 1/4" out from the stitching. Press the pink triangle open with seam allowance toward the triangle to complete (1) 3" x 5 1/2" A unit. Repeat to make 8 A units. Repeat on both ends of the remaining fuchsia rectangles to make 12 each B and C units, placing the diagonal seams as shown.



3. Place a marked 3 3/8" pink square right sides together with a 3 3/8" fuchsia square. Sew 1/4" out on each side of the line. Cut apart on the line. Press the units open with seam allowance to the fuchsia edge to complete (2) 3" x 3" D units. Repeat to make 8 D units.

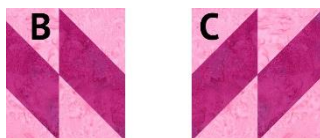


4. Stitch a 3" unmarked pink square to each D unit to make 3" x 5 1/2" D strips. Press seam toward the square. Sew an A unit to each D strip to make (8) 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" point units. Press seam toward the A unit.



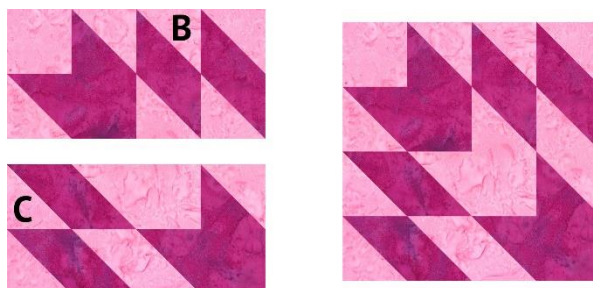
Point Unit — Make 8

5. Join 2 B units to make a 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" double-B unit. Press seam to the left. Repeat to make 4 units. Repeat with C units to make 4 double-C units.



Double Units — Make 4 of each

6. Sew a double-B unit to a point unit to make a 5 1/2" x 10 1/2" row. Press seam toward the point unit. Repeat with a double-C unit and a point unit to make a second row. Join the rows to complete (1) 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" Corner block. Press seam down. Repeat to make 4 blocks.

7. Stitch 3" x 29 1/2" pink and fuchsia strips lengthwise together to make (2) 5 1/2" x 29 1/2" short pieced strips. Press seam to the fuchsia edge. Repeat with 3" x 37 1/2" strips to make (2) 5 1/2" x 37 1/2" long pieced strips.

8. Sew a B unit to 1 end and a C unit to the remaining end of each pieced strip to make 2 each 5 1/2" x 34 1/2" short strip units and 5 1/2" x 42 1/2" long strip units. Press seams toward the pieced strips.



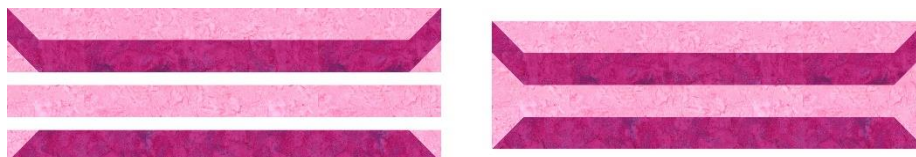
Strip Unit — Make 2 each short & long

9. Repeat step 2 with marked 3" pink squares on both ends of the 3" x 34 1/2" and 3" x 42 1/2" fuchsia strips.



Angled Fuchsia Strip — Make 2 each short & long

10. Stitch a same-length pink strip and then a same-length angled fuchsia strip to each short strip unit to make (2) 10 1/2" x 34 1/2" short border units. Press seam toward the aqua strips. Repeat with long strip units and same-length pink and angled fuchsia strips to make (2) 10 1/2" x 42 1/2" long border units.

Completing the Quilt

1. Sew the long border units to the sides of the panel. Press seams toward the border units.
2. Stitch a Corner block to each end of the short border units to make (2) 10 1/2" x 54 1/2" borders. Press seams away from the Corner blocks.
3. Sew the borders to the top and bottom of the panel section to complete the 54 1/2" x 62 1/2" quilt center. Press seams toward the borders.
4. Stitch the 2 1/2" x WOF purple hand-dye strips short ends together to make a long strip. Press seams to one side. Cut into 2 strips each 62 1/2" and 53 1/2". Sew the longer strips to the sides of the quilt center and the shorter strips to the top and bottom to complete the top. Press seams toward the strips.
5. If using 42" backing fabric, remove the selvage edges from the backing pieces. Join the pieces on the long edges with a 1/2" seam allowance. Press seam open. Trim to make the 73" x 81" backing piece.
6. Layer the quilt top with the backing and batting pieces. Quilt as desired. Trim batting and backing even with the top.
7. Join the dark amethyst hand-dye binding strips on the short ends with diagonal seams to make a long strip. Press seams in one direction. Press the strip in half along the length with wrong sides together. Bind the quilt edges using your favorite method to complete the quilt.
