Skill Level: Confident Beginner

Finished Quilt Size: 57 1/2" x 49 1/2"

Please read all instructions before beginning. Pre-washing NOT recommended.

Yardages and Cutting

WOF is 42" width of fabric from selvedge edge to selvedge edge.

Remove as little fabric as possible when removing selvages and squaring strip ends.

1 Sorcerer's Apprentice panel

- Trim to 41 1/2" x 33 1/2"

1/2 rainbows print

- Fussy-cut (4) 5 1/2" squares, centering an image in each square

1 yard medium blue hand-dye

- 2 strips 2" x WOF; trim to 41 1/2"
- 2 strips 2" x WOF; trim to 36 1/2"
- 6 strips 2" x WOF for outer border

1 yard blue skies print

- 2 strips 5 1/2" x WOF; trim to 36 1/2"
- 3 strips 5 1/2" x WOF for border

3/4 yard dark blue print

- 7 strips 2 1/4" x WOF for binding

Backing:

3 3/4 yards of 42" backing

- 2 pieces 64" x WOF

OR

2 yards wide backing fabric

- 1 piece 64" x 72"

Batting

- 1 piece 64" x 72"

Completing the Quilt

Use a 1/4" seam allowance for all stitching. Press seams as directed. Refer to the exploded quilt diagram as needed.

1. Sew a 2" x 41 1/2" medium blue hand dye strip to the top and bottom of the panel. Sew a 2" x 36 1/2" medium blue hand dye strip to each side, completing the framed panel. Press seams toward the strips.
2. Sew the 5 1/2" x 36 1/2" blue skies print strips to each side of the framed panel. Press seams toward the framed center. Sew the remaining 5 1/2" x WOF blue skies strips short ends together to make one long strip. Press seams to one side. Cut into (2) 5 1/2" x 44 1/2" strips.
3. Being careful with the orientation, sew a 5 1/2" rainbow square onto each end of the 44 1/2" strips from step 2 above to make the top border. Press seams toward the rainbow squares. Sew onto the framed center, pressing seam toward the center. Repeat to make the bottom border, and sew to the quilt center.
4. Sew the remaining 2" x WOF blue hand-dye strips short ends together to make a long strip. Press seams to 1 side. Cut into (2) *each* 46 1/2" and 57 1/2" strips. Stitch the shorter strips to the sides of the quilt and the longer strips to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top. Press seams toward the strips.
5. If using 42" backing fabric, remove the selvedge edges from the backing pieces. Join the pieces on the long edges with a 1/2" seam allowance. Press seams open. Trim to make the 64" x 72" backing piece.
6. Layer the quilt top with the backing and batting pieces. Quilt as desired. Trim batting and backing even with the top.
7. Join the 2 1/4" dark blue binding strips on the short ends with diagonal seams to make a long strip. Press seams in one direction. Press the strip in half along the length with wrong sides together. Bind the quilt edges using your favorite method to complete the quilt.
