

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FABRIC: Loons by Darrell Bush for Elizabeth's Studio LLC

8909 Black (block panel)—1 panel 24x44" **8910 Blue (large scale scenic)**—2/3 yard **454 Brown (pinecones)**—2/3 yard
176 Green (trees)—2/3 yard
528 Lake (water)—5/8 yard
371 Gray (birch trees)—1/2 yard
424 Green (cattails)—3/4 yard (includes binding)
Backing for 46-1/2" square (3-1/4 yards) or 1-3/4 yards wide Backing.

Cutting Directions:

8909 Black (block panel): Fussy cut (4) 10-1/2" squares from smaller squares of panel, centering motifs as desired.

8910 Blue (large scale scenic): Cut (2) 5-7/8" x WOF (width of fabric) strips, then cross cut into (8) 5-7/8" squares. Cross cut squares once diagonally, being sure to cut (4) in each direction.

454 Brown (pinecones): Cut (1) 5-7/8" x WOF strip, then cross cut into (4) 5-7/8" squares. Cut (4) 3-3/8" strips, cross cut into (32) 3-3/8" squares. Cut 5-7/8" and 3-3/8" squares once diagonally.

176 Green (trees): Cut (1) 5-7/8" x WOF strip, then cross cut into (4) 5-7/8" squares. Cut (4) 3-3/8" strips, cross cut into (32) 3-3/8" squares. Cut 5-7/8" and 3-3/8" squares once diagonally, being sure to cut (4) in each direction.

528 Lake (water): Cut (3) 6-1/4" x WOF strips, cross cut into (16) 6-1/4" squares. Cut these squares twice diagonally.

371 Gray (birch trees) : Cut (6) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, cross cut into (12) 2-1/2" x 20-1/2" sashing strips.

424 Green (cattails): Cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, cross cut into (9) 2-1/2" squares. Then cut (5) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, set aside for binding.

HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE UNITS:



Combine 5-7/8" **8910 Blue (overall scenic)** half-square triangles and **454 Brown (pinecones)** half-square triangles to form (8) corner units.

Repeat using 5-7/8" **8910 Blue (overall scenic)** half-square triangles and **176 Green (trees)** to form (8) corner units. Be sure to keep the scenes and trees correctly oriented (up and down).



FLYING GEESE UNITS:

Use **528 Lake (water)** quarter square triangles and **454 Brown (pinecones)** half-square triangles to form flying geese units. You will have a total of (32) Lake/Pinecone flying geese units.



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
Repeat using **528 Lake (water)** quarter square triangles and **176 Green (trees)** half-square triangles to form (32) flying geese units. Be sure to orient lake (side to side) and trees (up and down).



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Sew together 4 flying geese units together, being careful of orientation. Repeat to complete (8) pinecone units and (8) tree units.



COMPLETING THE BLOCKS:

Referring to diagram for placement, combine (4) corner units, (4) flying geese units, and (1) fussy-cut 10-1/2" square to form (2) lake/pinecone blocks and (2) lake/tree blocks—again, be careful of the placement of the units.



COMPLETING THE CENTER SECTION:

Sew the four blocks together, along with 2-1/2" x 20-1/2" **371 Gray (Birch trees)** sashing strips and 2-1/2" **424 Green (cattails)** squares to form the quilt top.

COMPLETING THE QUILT:

Layer with batting and backing. Use the reserved binding strips to complete the quilt.
