

Lovely Pansies

53-1/2" x 53-1/2"

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Fabric Requirements:

(Featured Fabrics are from Elizabeth's Studio Lovely Pansies collection)

474 Black (pansy blocks)—1 yard (additional 1/3 yard can give more color choices)

560 Yellow (pansies)—1 1/4 yards (includes binding)

561 Purple (pansies)—1 yard

P546 White (pearl tone-on-tone)—2-1/2 yards

475 Multi (pansies)—1/2 yard for border

Backing Fabric: 3-1/2 yards
or 2 yards of Wide Backing

Batting: for 54" x 54" quilt

Cutting:

474 Black (pansy blocks): Fussy cut (13) 6-1/2" pansy blocks, centering motifs.

560 Yellow (pansies): Cut (7) 2-3/8" x WOF (width of fabric) strips, cross cut into (104) 2-3/8" squares. Cut each square once on the diagonal to form (208) half-square triangles. 

561 Purple (pansies): Cut (6) 3-7/8" x WOF strips, cross cut into (52) 3-7/8" squares. Cut each square once on the diagonal to form (104) half-square triangles. 

P546 White (pearl tone-on-tone): First, cut (1) 18-1/8" x WOF strip, cut each strip into (2) 18-1/8" squares. Cut squares twice diagonally to form (8) quarter-square side setting triangles. 

Cut (1) 9-3/8" x WOF strip, cut into (2) 9-3/8" squares, cut once diagonally to form (4) half-square corner setting triangles. 

Cut (6) 2" x WOF strips, cross cut into (104) 2" squares.

Cut (7) 2-3/8" x WOF strips, cross cut into (104) 2-3/8" squares. Cut each square once on the diagonal to form (208) half-square triangles. 

Cut (3) 4-1/4" X WOF strips, cross cut into (26) 4-1/4" squares, then cut twice diagonally to form (104) quarter square triangles. 

475 Multi (pansies): Cut (6) 1-1/2" x WOF strips for border, set aside.

560 Yellow (pansies): Cut (6) 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding, set aside.



Pansy Block (make 13):

Make the yellow pansies/pearl white half-square triangles:

Sew together (1) **560 Yellow (pansies)** 2-3/8" triangle and (1) **P546 White (pearl tone-on-tone)** 2-3/8" triangle to form a half-square triangle block. Repeat to make a total of (104) half square units.



Make the corner four-patch units:

Use (104) 2" **P546 White (pearl tone-on-tone)** squares and (104) half-square units from above step to form four-patch corner unit. Be careful to orient the yellow triangles to the center. Repeat to make a total of (52) corner units.



Make the star point sections: Sew together (1) 4-1/4" **P546 White (pearl tone-on-tone)** quarter-square triangle and (2) 2-3/8" **560 Yellow (pansies)** half-square triangles to form first part of unit.

Sew (2) 2-3/8" **P546 White (pearl tone-on-tone)** triangles to each side of unit, being sure to orient the triangles correctly. Then add (1) 4-1/4" **P546 White (pearl tone-on-tone)** quarter-square triangle to the bottom of this unit.



Finally, add (2) 3-7/8" **561 Purple (pansies)** half-square triangles to each side of the unit to complete the star point section. Repeat steps to make (52) complete star point sections.



Assemble the Pansy blocks:

First Row: Sew together (1) yellow pansies/white corner unit, one star point unit, and (1) yellow pansies/white corner unit to form first row. Maintain proper orientation of units.



Second row: Sew together (1) star point unit, (1) fussy-cut 6-1/2" **474 Black (pansy block)**, and (1) star point unit to form second row.



Third row: Same as the first row.

Sew together three rows to form complete pansy block.



Make a total of 13 blocks.


Assembling the Quilt Top:

Assemble the Rows:

Sew the blocks and $18\frac{1}{8}$ " quarter-square setting triangles together into rows.

Complete the quilt top:

Sew the rows together, taking care not to stretch the edges. Add the $9\frac{3}{8}$ " half-square corner triangles.



FINISHING THE QUILT :

Border:

Sew together the 1-1/2" strips of **475 Multi (pansies)** to form one long strip. Cut (2) 51-1/2" strips and add to sides of quilt top. Cut (2) 53-1/2" strips and add to top and bottom of quilt top.

Prepare Backing:

Cut backing fabric in half across the width of the fabric, and sew together on long edges to form backing.

Completing Quilt:

Layer quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Use 2-1/2" **560 Yellow (pansies)** strips to bind quilt.
