# FABRICS: Tis' the Season by Alan Giana for Elizabeth's Studio LLC

13002 Red (Blocks)—1 yard (8 blocks)
13003 Snow (Large Scale Scenic)—1-1/2 yard
532 Snow (Light Blue Snowflakes)—1/4 yard
532 Royal (Blue Snowflakes)—1/2 yard
Red Solid—1/2 yard
White Solid—3/4 yard
Binding fabric (532 Snow)—1/2 yard
Backing fabric—for 48-1/2"x 48-1/2" quilt top (3-1/2 yards)
Batting for 48-1/2" x 48-1/2" quilt top

#### **CUTTING DIRECTIONS:**

**13002 Red (Blocks):** Fussy cut (8) 9-1/2" squares, centering motifs. **13003 Snow Large Scale Scenic:** From WIDTH of Fabric, cut (2) 4-1/2" x 38-1/2" top/bottom borders. From remaining fabric, cut (2) 4-1/2" x LENGTH of Fabric side borders, trim to 4-1/2" x 38-1/2". From remaining fabric, fussy-cut (8) 5" squares, centering motifs as desired.

**532 Snow:** Cut (3) 1-5/8" x Width of Fabric (WOF) strips for Four Patch units.

**532 Royal:** Cut (3) 3-1/8" x WOF, cross cut into (32) 3-1/8" squares, cut squares once diagonally (64 triangles).  $\square$ 

For corner stars, cut (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, cut into (4) 2-1/2" squares and (16) 1-7/8" squares. Cut 1-7/8" squares once diagonally (32 triangles).  $\square$ 

**Red Solid:** Cut (2) 1-1/2" x 36-1/2" and (2) 1-1/2" x 38-1/2" strips for inner border. Cut (5) 1-1/2" x WOF strips for outer border. Set aside.

White solid: Cut (3) 1-5/8" x WOF strips for four patch units. Cut (3) 2-3/4" x WOF strips, cross cut into (32) 2-3/4" squares. Cut (2) 5-3/4" x WOF, cross cut into (8) 5-3/4" squares. Cut 5-3/4" squares twice diagonally (32 triangles).  $\square$ 

For corner stars, cut (1) 3-1/4" strip, cut into (4) 3-1/4" squares and (16) 1-1/2" squares. Cut 3-1/4" squares twice diagonally (16 triangles). ⊠

Binding Fabric (532 Snow): Cut (6) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, set aside.



#### **SNOWBALL BLOCKS: (make 8)**

Draw a diagonal line across 2-3/4"

White Solid square. Align with cor-



ner of 9-1/2" fussy-cut **13002 Red** 

block. Sew on line. Trim 1/4" from sewn line. Press. Repeat to add white squares to each corner of (8) blocks.

# LARGE STAR BLOCKS: (make 8) Four Patch Units:




Sew together (1) 1-5/8" **532 Snow** and (1) 1-5/8" **White** 

**Solid** strip along long edges. Repeat with remaining

1-5/8" strips. Cut into (64)


1-5/8" segments. Sew together segments to form (32) four patch units.






#### **Making the Star Point Units:**

Sew together the larger **White Solid** triangles (5-3/4" squares cut twice diagonally) and the larger **532** 



**Royal** (3-1/8" triangles cut once diagonally) to form 32 star point units.

#### **Assembling the Star Blocks:**







block. Be sure to maintain the orientation of the four patch units in the corners. Repeat to complete (8) star blocks.

### ASSEMBLING THE QUILT TOP

Sew together the snowball and star blocks to form center section of quilt top. Be sure to maintain orientation of the center squares (scenes facing up).



#### **BORDERS:**

**INNER RED BORDER:** Add 1-1/2" x 36-1/2" borders to sides of quilt top. Add 1-1/2" x 38-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt top.

#### **SCENIC BORDER:**



CONSTRUCT CORNER STAR BLOCKS: Following instructions for Star Point Units at left, use smaller **White Solid** triangles (3-1/4" squares cut twice diagonally) and smaller **532 Royal** triangles



(1-7/8" squares cut once diagonally) to make (16) star point units. Sew together the 1-1/2" **White Solid** squares, the star point units, and the **532 Royal** 2-1/2" squares to form (4) corner stars.

Add 4-1/2" x 38-1/2" Length of Fabric **13003 Snow Large Scale Scenic** borders to sides of quilt top, keeping scenes right side up. Sew Corner stars to ends of 4-1/2" x 38-1/2" Width of Fabric borders. Sew to top and bottom of quilt top.

**OUTER RED BORDER:** Sew together the (5) 1-1/2" x WOF **Red Solid** strips along short edges. From this long strip, cut (2) 1-1/2" x 46-1/2" strips and (2) 1-1/2" x 48-1/2" strips. Add 46-1/2" strips to sides of quilt, then add 48-1/2" strips to top and bottom of quilt.

### **FINISHING THE QUILT**

Layer quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Use 2-1/2" **532 Snow** strips to bind quilt.
