## - Call of the Wild Winter WoIf

Quilt Designed by eQuilter


WOF is $43^{\prime \prime}$ width of fabric from selvedge edge to selvedge edge.
Remove as little fabric as possible when trimming selvedges and squaring strip ends

1 Call of the Wild Moonstruck Wolf panel

- Trim panel to $291 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 421 / 2^{\prime \prime}$


## 1 1/2 yards charcoal tonal print

- 4 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF; subcut into: (2) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x $331 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and (2) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 421 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips
- 7 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF; join strips short ends together to make a long strip. Cut into:
(2) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 671 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and (2) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ 58 1/2" strips.
- 4 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF; subcut into: (24) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x $61 / 2$ " rectangles.
- 3 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF; subcut into: (12) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ $41 / 2$ " rectangles and (12) $21 / 2$ " squares.


## $13 / 4$ yards blue tonal print

- 12 strips $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF for borders
- 8 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF; subcut into: (48) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips
- 7 strips $21 / 4^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ WOF for binding


## $13 / 4$ yards gray hand dye

- 3 strips $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF. Join strips short ends together to make a long strip. Cut into (2) $31 / 2$ " $x$ 63 1/2" strips
- 6 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF. Join strips short ends together to make a long strip. Cut into (2) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x $481 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips, and (2) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 541 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Label each pair.
- 10 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF; subcut into: (12) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles, (12) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles, (24) $21 / 2$ " $\times 41 / 2$ " rectangles and (24) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.


## Backing:

$4 \mathbf{1 / 4}$ yards of 42" backing fabric

- 2 strips $75^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF

OR
2 1/4 yards wide backing fabric

- 1 piece $75^{\prime \prime} \times 88^{\prime \prime}$


## Batting

- 1 piece $75^{\prime \prime}$ x $88^{\prime \prime}$


Use a 1/4" seam allowance for all stitching. Press all seams toward darker fabric where applicable.

1. Place a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ charcoal tonal rectangle on top of a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ gray hand dye rectangle, right sides together, as shown below on the left side. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner and stitch on the line. Following the cut line, trim the excess and press open. Place a $21 / 2 " \times 1 / 2$ " blue tonal rectangle on top of the resulting 2 joined pieces, right sides together, as shown below on the left side. Stitch, trim and press open, as before. Place a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ gray hand dye square on top of the resulting 3 joined pieces, right sides together, as shown below on the left side. Stitch, trim and press open, as before. Repeat to make (6) Block Units 1A.
2. Repeat step 1 as mirror opposite, as shown on the right side below to make (6) Block Units 1B.

3. Place a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ blue tonal rectangle on top of a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ gray hand dye rectangle, right sides together, as shown below on the left side. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner and stitch on the line.
Following the cut line, trim the excess and press open. Place a $21 / 2$ " $\times 61 / 2$ " charcoal tonal rectangle on top of the resulting 2 joined pieces, right sides together, as shown below on the left side. Stitch, trim and press open, as before. Place a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ gray hand dye square on top of the resulting 3 joined pieces, right sides together, as shown below on the left side. Stitch, trim and press open, as before. Repeat to make (6) Block Units 2A.
4. Repeat step 3 as mirror opposite, as shown on the right side below to make (6) Block Units 2B.

5. Place a $21 / 2$ " $\times 1 / 2$ " blue tonal rectangle on top of a $21 / 2^{" \prime} \times 1 / 2$ " gray hand dye rectangle, right sides together, as shown below on the left side. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner and stitch on the line. Following the cut line, trim the excess and press open. Place a $21 / 2$ " $\times 41 / 2$ " charcoal tonal rectangle on top of the resulting 2 joined pieces, right sides together, as shown below on the left side. Stitch, trim and press open, as before. Repeat to make (6) Block Units 3A.
6. Repeat step 5 as mirror opposite, as shown on the right side below to make (6) Block Units 3B.

7. Place a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ blue tonal rectangle on top of a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ gray hand dye rectangle, right sides together, as shown below on the left side. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner and stitch on the line. Following the cut line, trim the excess and press open. Place a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ charcoal tonal square on top of the resulting 2 joined pieces, right sides together, as shown below on the left side. Stitch, trim and press open, as before. Repeat to make (6) Block Units 4A.
8. Repeat step 7 as mirror opposite, as shown on the right side below to make (6) Block Units 4B.

9. Sew together Block Units as follows: 4A, 3A, 2A, 1A, 1B, 2B, 3B, 4B, as shown below. Press seams. Repeat to make (6) Mountain Blocks.


Mountain Block - Make 6


Refer to the exploded quilt diagram as needed throughout the following steps.
Press all seams toward darker fabric where applicable.

1. Sew the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 421 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ charcoal strips to the top and bottom of the Moonstruck Wolf panel. Then sew the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 331 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ charcoal strips to the sides of the quilt center.
2. Sew the $11 / 2^{" \prime} \times$ WOF blue tonal strips short ends to make a long strip. Press seams to one side. Cut into: (2) $11 / 2 " \times 331 / 2 "$ strips, (2) $11 / 2 " \times 481 / 2 "$ strips, (2) $11 / 2 " \times 711 / 2 "$ strips, and (2) $11 / 2 " \times 601 / 2 "$ strips. Label each pair.
3. Sew the $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 331 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ blue tonal strips to the sides of the quilt center. Then sew the $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 481 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ blue tonal strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center.
4. Sew the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 481 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ gray hand dye strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center.
5. Join (3) Mountain Blocks together to make a $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 481 / 2^{"}$ Mountain Border. Sew this border to the top of the quilt center. Join the remaining (3) Mountain Blocks together and sew to the bottom of the quilt center.
6. Sew the $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 631 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ gray hand dye strips to the sides of the quilt center. Then sew the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 541 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ gray hand dye strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center.
7. Sew the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 671 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ charcoal tonal strips to the sides of the quilt center. Then sew the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 581 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ charcoal tonal strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center.
8. Sew the $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 711 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ blue tonal strips to the sides of the quilt center. Then sew the $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 601 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ blue tonal strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center to complete the $601 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 731 / 2 "$ quilt top.
9. If using $42^{\prime \prime}$ backing fabric, remove the selvage edges from the backing pieces. Join the pieces on the long edges with a $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance. Press seam open. Trim to make an $75^{\prime \prime} \times 88^{\prime \prime}$ backing piece.
10. Layer the quilt top with the backing and batting pieces. Quilt as desired. Trim batting and backing even with the top.
11. Join the $21 / 4 "$ blue tonal binding strips short ends together with diagonal seams to make a long strip. Press seams in one direction. Press the strip in half along the length with wrong sides together. Bind the quilt edges using your favorite method to complete the quilt.
