Quilt size: 64" x 78"

Fabric Requirements

1/4 yard each Fabric 1 – J7040-4G Black Gold Fabric 2 – J7041-4G Black Gold Fabric 3 - J7037-21G Teal Gold

7/8 yard Fabric 4 – J7034-4G Black Gold 5/8 yard Fabric 5 – J7036-21G Teal Gold 1-7/8 yards Fabric 6 – J7038-4G Black Gold 1-1/4 yard Fabric 7 – J7035-4G Black Gold 1-1/2 yards Cream – G8555-33G Cream 1 yard Seafoam – G8555-79G Seafoam

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

*WOF refers to width of fabric (selvage to selvage).

*LOF refers to length of fabric (parallel to the selvage).

*Fabrics are directional. Make sure when sewing units and sections that the fabric print faces up. *Press all quilt seams to the Cream 1-1/2" strips unless otherwise indicated.

Cutting instructions:

Fabric 1: Cut four 6-1/2" x 6-1/2".

Fabric 2: Cut three 6-1/2" x 6-1/2".

Fabric 3: Cut four 6-1/2" x 6-1/2".

Fabric 4: Cut five 13-1/2" x 13-1/2".

Fabric 5: Cut three 6-1/2" x WOF; sub-cut into one 6-1/2" x 27-1/2", one 6-1/2" x 20-1/2", one 6-1/2" x 7-1/2" and five 6-1/2" x 6-1/2".

Fabric 6: Cut two 5-1/2" x 64" LOF along selvage edge. (Cut first) Cut five 5-1/2" x remaining WOF. Cut six 6-1/2" x 6-1/2".

Fabric 7: Cut three 6-1/2" x 41-1/2" LOF.

Cream: Cut three 4-1/2" x WOF; sub-cut into twenty 4-1/2" x 4-1/2".

Cut **four** 2-1/2" x WOF; sub-cut into (**60**) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2".


Cut seventeen 1-1/2" x WOF; sub-cut from 11 strips: two 1-1/2" x 41-1/2"; two 34-1/2" x 1-1/2"; one 1-1/2" x 27-1/2"; three 1-1/2" x 20-1/2"; eight 1-1/2" x 13-1/2"; one 1-1/2" x 7-1/2"; and twelve 1-1/2" x 6-1/2".

Seafoam: Cut six 2" x WOF for border 2. Cut eight 2-1/4" x WOF for binding.

Block construction:

Snowball blocks and snowball corners

- 1. Draw a diagonal line on the backs of the Cream 2-1/2" and 4-1/2" squares.
- 2. Place the 2-1/2" Cream squares, right sides together, on each corner of the four 6-1/2" Fabric 1 squares. Sew on drawn line, trim seam to 1/4" and press to triangle.





- 3. Repeat step 2 with the three 6-1/2" Fabric 2 squares and four 6-1/2" Fabric 6 squares.
- Repeat step 2 with the 6-1/2" x 27-1/2"
 Fabric 5.
- Fabric 7 strip (for left side). Cut to
 6-1/2" x 41-1/2". Repeat step 2 on the corners.
- Sew two 6-1/2" x 41-1/2" Fabric 7 strips (for right side) ends together, with straight seams, trim to 6-1/2" x 55-1/2".
 Repeat step 2 on all four corners.

7. Place the 4-1/2" Cream squares, right sides together on the corners of the five 13-1/2" Fabric 4 squares. Repeat step 2.

8. Place the 2-1/2" **Cream** squares, right sides together on the left corners (fabric pattern facing up) of the 6-1/2" x 20-1/2" **Fabric**

5. Repeat step 2.



9. Place the 2-1/2" Cream squares, right sides together on the right corners (fabric pattern facing up) of the 6-1/2" x 7-1/2" Fabric 5. Repeat step 2.

UNIT CONSTRUCTION

Unit 1

10. Sew a 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" **Cream** to each side of a 6-1/2" **Fabric 3** square.

11. Sew a 6-1/2" Fabric 6 Snowball block to the left side and 6-1/2" Fabric 1 Snowball block to the right side. Make 2 Unit 1.



Unit 2

12. Repeat step 10 with a Fabric 2 Snowball block.

13. Sew two 6-1/2" Fabric 5 squares to the left and right sides. Fab 5 Fab 2 Fab 5

Unit 3

14. Sew a 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" Cream between a 6-1/2" Fabric 5 square and Fabric 6 Snowball block, with the Fabric 5 square on the left side.

Unit 4

15. Repeat step 14 with the 6-1/2" Fabric 3 square and 6-1/2" Fabric 1 Snowball block, placing the Fabric 3 square on the right side.

Unit 5

16. Repeat step 14 with a 6-1/2" **Fabric 5** square and **Fabric 2** Snowball block placing the **Fabric 5** square on the left.

Unit 6

14. Repeat step 14 with a 6-1/2"
Fabric 5 square and Fabric 2 Snowball block. The Fabric 5 print should be facing up, on top and the Fabric 2 Snowball block on the bottom.



Unit 7

15. Repeat step 14 with a 6-1/2" Fabric 5 square and Fabric 1 Snowball block placing the Fabric 5 on the left.

Unit 8


16. Repeat step 14 with a 6-1/2" Fabric 3 square and Fabric 6 Snowball block placing the Fabric 3 square on the right.

SECTION CONSTRUCTION

Section 1

17. Sew a 1-1/2" x 20-1/2" Cream between the Unit 1 and the 6-1/2" x 20-1/2" Fabric 5, placing it on top. The snowball corners should be on the left.


18. Sew a 13-1/2" Fabric 4 Snowball block to the left side of Section 1 with a 1-1/2" x 13-1/2" Cream between them.



Section 2

19. Sew a 1-1/2" x 20-1/2" Cream between a Unit 1 and Unit 2, with Unit 2 on top.


20. Sew a 13-1/2" **Fabric 4** Snowball block to the right side with a 1-1/2" x 13-1/2" **Cream** between them.



Section 3


21. Sew a 1-1/2" x 13-1/2" Cream between a Unit 3 and Unit 4, with the Unit 3 on top.

22. Sew a 13-1/2" Fabric 4 Snowball block between Units 3/4 and Unit 6 with two 1-1/2" x 13-1/2" Cream connecting them.




Section 4

- 23. Sew a 1-1/2" x 13-1/2" Cream between a Unit 5 and Unit 8, with the Unit 5 on top.
- 24. Sew a 13-1/2" Fabric 4 Snowball block to the left side with a 1-1/2" x 13-1/2" Cream between them.
- 25. Sew the 6-1/2" x 27-1/2" Fabric 5 to the bottom with a 1-1/2" x 27-1/2" Cream between them.




Section 5

- 26. Sew a 13-1/2" Fabric 4 Snowball block to the bottom side of Unit 7 with a 1-1/2" x 13-1/2" Cream between them.
- 27. Sew this to the right side of Section 4 with a 1-1/2" x 20-1/2" Cream between them.



Quilt construction

- 28. Sew Sections 1, 2, and 3 together with two 1-1/2" x 34-1/2" Cream.
- **29**. Sew the 6-1/2" x 41-1/2" **Fabric 7** to the left with a 1-1/2" x 41-1/2" **Cream**.
- **30**. Sew this section to the top of **Section 5** with a 1-1/2" x 41-1/2" **Cream**.
- **31**. Sew two 1-1/2" x WOF **Cream** strips, short ends together, with a diagonal seam. Trim to 55-1/2". Sew the 1-1/2" x 55-1/2" **Cream** to the left side of the 1-1/2" x 55-1/2" **Fabric 7**.
- **32**. Sew the 6-1/2" x 7-1/2" **Fabric 5** half Snowball block (with snowball side on the right) to the **Fabric 7** section with a 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" **Cream** between them.
- 33. Sew this to the right side of the quilt top.



Border construction

- **34**. Sew the **six** 1-1/2" **Cream** strips together with diagonal seams.
- **35**. Measure through the vertical (top to bottom) quilt center and cut two strips to this length. Matching centers and ends, sew to sides of quilt.

- **36**. Measure through the horizontal (side to side) center of the quilt and cut the remaining 1-1/2" strip to this width. Matching centers and ends, sew to top and bottom of quilt.
- Repeat steps 35, 36, and 37 with the 2"
 Seafoam strips.
- **38**. Sew **five** 5-1/2" x WOF **Fabric 6** strips, short ends together, with diagonal seams.
- **39**. Measure through the vertical center and cut two strips to this length. Matching centers and ends sew to sides of the quilt.

40. Measure through the horizontal center and trim the **two** 5-1/2" x 64" **Fabric 6** LOF strips to this width. Matching centers and ends sew to top and bottom of the quilt.

Layer, quilt and bind with the **eight** 2-1/4" **Seafoam** strips sewn together with diagonal seams, using a French binding technique.

Put a label on the back and ENJOY!
