You will also need:

- 60" x 69" piece of batting

Cutting Instructions:

- Fabric A:** • Cut six 4½" high x 10½" wide strips (Directional Fabric)
- Fabric B:** • Cut one 5½" high x 10½" wide strip (Directional Fabric)
• Cut five 4½" high x 10½" wide strips
- Fabric C:** • Cut one 5½" high x 10 ½" wide strip (Directional Fabric)
• Cut five 4½" high x 10½" wide strips
- Fabric D:** (Directional Fabric- Piece as needed for the borders)
• Cut two 3" x 56½" strips for the side borders
• Cut two 3" x 52½" strips for the top and bottom borders
• Cut one 5½" high x 10½" wide strip
• Cut five 4½" high x 10½" wide strips
- Fabric E:** • Cut one 3½" x 36½" strip for the center bottom border
• Cut one 1½" x 36½" strip for the center top border
• Cut two 1½" x 41½" strips for the center side borders
• Cut six 1½" x 42" strips. Piece the strips together to make two 1½" x 54½" strips and two 1½" x 47½" strips for the inner borders.
• Cut one 2⅜" x 42" strip. Sub-cut the strip into eight 2⅜" squares
• Cut one 2" x 42" strip. Sub-cut the strip into sixteen 2" squares.
- Fabric F:** • Cut two 2⅜" x 42" strips. Sub-cut the strips into eighteen 2⅜" squares.
• Cut two 2" x 42" strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-six 2" squares.

- Fabric G:**
- Cut two 2 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 42" strips. Sub-cut the strips into eighteen 2 $\frac{3}{8}$ " squares.
 - Cut two 2" x 42" strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-six 2" squares.
- Fabric H:**
- Cut one 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strip. Sub-cut the strip into one 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip, one 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip and one 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square for the tree trunks.
 - Cut two 2 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 42" strips. Sub-cut the strips into eighteen 2 $\frac{3}{8}$ " squares.
 - Cut two 2" x 42" strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-six 2" squares.
- Fabric I:**
- Cut two 2 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 42" strips. Sub-cut the strips into eighteen 2 $\frac{3}{8}$ " squares.
 - Cut two 2" x 42" strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-six 2" squares.
- Fabric J:**
- Cut one 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strip. Sub-cut the strip into one 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square and one 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.
 - Cut one 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strip. Sub-cut the strip into six 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
 - Cut five 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strips. Sub-cut the strips into forty-four 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
 - Cut five 2 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 42" strips. Sub-cut the strips into eighty 2 $\frac{3}{8}$ " squares.
 - Cut two 2" x 42" strips. Sub-cut the strips into forty 2" squares.
 - Cut three 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 42" strips. Sub-cut the strips into eighty 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " squares.
 - Cut one 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strip. Sub-cut the strip into two 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and two 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
 - Cut four 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 41 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Binding:**
- Cut six 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" strips for the binding.
- Backing:**
- Cut two 60" x 42" strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make one 60" x 69" square.

Assembly Instructions:

TREES

1. Place one 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J square on the left side of the 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.
2. Place another 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J square on the right side of the 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 4). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance to make the left tree top unit.
3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make the middle tree top unit, using two 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J squares and the 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip (Fig. 5).
4. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make the right tree top unit using two 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J squares and the 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip (Fig. 6).







- Place one 4½" Fabric J square on the left side of the 4½" x 10½" Fabric A strip, right sides together (Fig. 7). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 7). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 8). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle leaving a ¼" seam allowance.
- Place another 4½" Fabric J square on the right side of the 4½" x 10½" Fabric A strip, right sides together (Fig. 9). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 9). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 10). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle leaving a ¼" seam allowance to make the one A tree unit.
- Repeat Step 6 to make six A tree units, five B tree units, five C tree units and five D tree units (Fig. 11).

- Sew one 2½" x 4½" Fabric J strip to each side of one 2½" Fabric H square to make the left tree trunk (Fig. 12).
- Sew one 4½" Fabric J square to each side of one 2½" x 4½" Fabric H strip to make the center tree trunk (Fig. 13).
- Sew one 3½" x 4½" Fabric J square to each side of one 2½" x 3½" Fabric H strip to make the right tree trunk (Fig. 14).
- Follow Figure 15 to sew together the left tree top unit, six assorted tree units, left trunk unit and one 10½" Fabric J square to make one 10½" x 41½" left tree unit.
- Follow Figure 16 to sew together the center tree top unit, eight assorted tree units and center trunk unit to make one 10½" x 41½" center tree unit.
- Follow Figure 17 to sew together the right tree top unit, seven assorted tree units, left trunk unit and one 5½" x 10½" Fabric J strip to make one 10½" x 41½" right tree unit.

QUILT TOP CENTER

- Sew together the three tree units and four $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 41\frac{1}{2}''$ Fabric J strips, alternating them to make the $34\frac{1}{2}'' \times 41\frac{1}{2}''$ quilt top center (Fig. 18).
- Sew one $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 41\frac{1}{2}''$ Fabric E strip to each side of the quilt top center. Sew one $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 36\frac{1}{2}''$ Fabric E strip to the top of the quilt top center. Sew one $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 36\frac{1}{2}''$ Fabric E strip to the bottom of the quilt top center to make the $36\frac{1}{2}'' \times 45\frac{1}{2}''$ quilt top (Fig. 19).





LEAF BORDERS

- Place one $1\frac{1}{4}''$ Fabric J square on the upper left corner of one $2''$ Fabric E square. Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to lower left corner (Fig. 20). Flip open the triangle formed and press (fig. 21). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $\frac{1}{4}''$ away from the sewn seam.
- Place another $1\frac{1}{4}''$ Fabric J square on the lower right corner of the $2''$ Fabric E square. Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to lower left corner (Fig. 22). Flip open the triangle formed and press (fig. 23). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $\frac{1}{4}''$ away from the sewn seam to make one $2''$ stem unit.





Fig. 24 Fabric H-make 9

- Repeat Steps 16-17 to make four Fabric E stem units, nine Fabric F stem units, nine Fabric G stem units, nine Fabric H stem units and nine Fabric I stem units (Fig. 24).





19. Place one 2 $\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric J square on top of one 2 $\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric E square, right side together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 25). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 25). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 26) to make two 2" E/J half-square triangles (Fig. 27).
20. Repeat Step 19 to make sixteen E/J half-square triangles, thirty-six F/J half-square triangles, thirty-six G/J half-square triangles, thirty-six H/J half-square triangles and thirty-six I/J half-square triangles (Fig. 28).
21. Follow Fig 29 to lay out one 2" Fabric J square, four E/J half-square triangles, three 2" Fabric E square and one Fabric E stem to make one 5" E Leaf block. Repeat to make four Fabric E leaf blocks total.
22. Repeat Step 21 to make nine Fabric F leaf blocks, nine Fabric G leaf blocks, nine Fabric H leaf blocks and nine Fabric I leaf blocks (Fig. 30).




Fabric F-make 36

23. Refer to the quilt photo for fabric placement and orientation to sew together ten assorted leaf blocks to make the left side border. Repeat to make the right side border, top border and bottom border. Sew the side borders to the quilt top. Sew the top and bottom borders to the quilt top to complete 45 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 54 $\frac{1}{2}$ " quilt top.
24. Sew one 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 54 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 47 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
25. Sew one 3" x 56 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 3" x 52 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
26. Layer, quilt and bind as desired.
