


Chickadee


FINISHED BLOCK SIZE: 9" x 9"

FINISHED QUILT SIZE: 60½" x 67½"

- Yardages are based on 40" fabric width.

Materials

- ⅔ yd. Panel Print (1JPC1) for quilt center
- ½ yd. Black Tonal Birds (8JPC5) for spacing strips
- ½ yd. Multicolor Large Floral/Birds (3JPC1) for blocks
- ⅔ yd. Yellow Medium Birds (4JPC1) for rectangles
- ⅔ yd. White Birds/Bugs (5JPC1) for rectangles
- ⅔ yd. Multicolor/Black Hearts (6JPC2) for rectangles
- ¾ yd. Yellow Tonal Birds (8JPC3) for blocks and binding
- ⅛ yd. Blue Spheres (7JPC2) for blocks
- ⅛ yd. Green Tonal Birds (8JPC1) for blocks
- ⅛ yd. Coral Spheres (7JPC4) for blocks
- ¼ yd. Green Spheres (7JPC5) for blocks
- ¼ yd. Blue Tonal Birds (8JPC4) for blocks
- ⅛ yd. Coral Tonal Birds (8JPC2) for blocks
- ⅛ yd. Yellow Spheres (7JPC3) for blocks
- 2⅝ yds. Border Stripe (2JPC1) for border (Yardage is generous to allow for selective cutting.)
- 4½ yds. for backing (vertical seam)



Cutting

Cut strips across width of fabric, unless otherwise instructed.

From Panel Print, selectively cut:

- 1 piece, approximately 22½" wide x 29½" long, for quilt center (Cut this piece to get the portion of the design shown in the photograph, plus ¼" seam allowance on each side.)

From Black Tonal Birds, cut:

- 4 strips, 2½" x 40", for framing center panel

From Multicolor Large Floral/Birds, cut:

- 2 strips, 6½" x 40"; crosscut 10 squares, 6½" x 6½", for blocks

From Yellow Medium Birds, cut:

- 1 strip, 9½" x 40"; crosscut 2 rectangles, 9½" x 7½" –and– 2 rectangles, 9½" x 4½"

From White Birds/Bugs, cut:

- 1 strip, 9½" x 40"; crosscut 1 rectangle, 9½" x 7½" –and– 2 rectangles, 9½" x 4½"

From Multicolor/Black Hearts, cut:

- 1 strip, 9½" x 40"; crosscut 1 rectangle, 9½" x 7½" –and– 2 rectangles, 9½" x 4½"

From Yellow Tonal Birds, cut:

- 7 strips, 2½" x 40", for double-fold binding
- 1 strip, 2" x 40"; crosscut 2 rectangles, 2" x 9½" –and– 2 rectangles, 2" x 6½"

From Blue Spheres, cut:

- 1 strip, 2" x 40"; crosscut 2 rectangles, 2" x 9½" –and– 2 rectangles, 2" x 6½"

From Green Tonal Birds, cut:

- 1 strip, 2" x 40"; crosscut 2 rectangles, 2" x 9½" –and– 2 rectangles, 2" x 6½"

From Coral Spheres, cut:

- 1 strip, 2" x 40"; crosscut 2 rectangles, 2" x 9½" –and– 2 rectangles, 2" x 6½"

From Green Spheres, cut:

- 1 strip, 2" x 40"; crosscut 4 rectangles, 2" x 9½"
- 1 strip, 2" x 40"; crosscut 4 rectangles, 2" x 6½"

From Blue Tonal Birds, cut:

- 1 strip, 2" x 40"; crosscut 4 rectangles, 2" x 9½"
- 1 strip, 2" x 40"; crosscut 4 rectangles, 2" x 6½"

From Coral Tonal Birds, cut:

- 1 strip, 2" x 40"; crosscut 2 rectangles, 2" x 9½" –and– 2 rectangles, 2" x 6½"

From Yellow Spheres, cut:

- 1 strip, 2" x 40"; crosscut 2 rectangles, 2" x 9½" –and– 2 rectangles, 2" x 6½"


From Border Stripe, selectively cut:

- 4 strips, approximately 10" x length of fabric, for border (Cut these strips to get the portion of the design shown in the photograph, plus ¼" seam allowance on each long side. Strips are cut long, and will be trimmed to size later.)


Assembly

All seams ¼". Press seams in direction of arrows unless otherwise instructed. Refer to photograph for fabric placement.


1. Measure length of Panel Print center rectangle. Trim 2 of the Black Tonal Birds strips to this measurement and sew to sides of center rectangle. Press seams toward framing strips. (See illustration in Step 2.)
2. Measure width of center rectangle, including strips just added. Trim remaining 2 Black Tonal Birds strips to this measurement and sew to top and bottom of center rectangle. Press seams toward framing strips.




3. Trim the center rectangle with framing strips so it measures 23½" x 30½".




4. Using 1 Multicolor Large Floral/Birds 6½" square, 2 matching 2" x 6½" rectangles, and 2 matching 2" x 9½" rectangles, assemble a block as shown. Repeat to make a total of 10 blocks.




5. Using 3 blocks and 2 assorted-print 9½" x 7½" rectangles, assemble a block row as shown. Repeat to make a total of 2 rows.





6. Using 2 blocks and 3 assorted-print 9½" x 4½" rectangles, assemble a block row as shown. Repeat to make a total of 2 rows.



7. Sew the rows made in Step 6 to the sides of the quilt center.



8. Sew the rows made in Step 5 to the top and bottom of the quilt center.

Borders

1. (**Note:** Study the photograph and decide how you would like the vine placement in the borders before trimming.) Measure length of quilt top through center. Trim 2 Border Stripe strips to this measurement, and sew to sides of quilt. Press seams toward borders.
2. (**Note:** Study the photograph and decide how you would like the vine placement in the borders before trimming.) Measure width of quilt top, including borders just added, through center. Trim remaining 2 Border Stripe strips to this measurement, and sew to top and bottom of quilt. Press seams toward borders.

Finishing

Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind. Don't forget to sign and date your finished quilt.
