## Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

3-3/4 yards for backing

## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## Cutting Instructions

Note: For all template A pieces, unfold each WOF strip before subcutting, to ensure that all template pieces face the same direction.

### **From Fabric A,**

fussy cut eight 9-1/2" x 11" panel blocks

### **From Fabric B,**

fussy cut one 9-1/2" x 11" rectangle and  
cut (7) strips 2-1/4" x WOF for Binding.

### **From Fabric C, cut:**

six 1-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut: eighteen 1-1/4" x 12-1/2" strips six 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
eighteen 2" x 11" strips

### **From Fabric D, cut:**

two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
(22) 2-1/2" squares

### **From Fabric E, cut:**

seven 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Set aside for inner border. seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
(88) Template A pieces  
(88) Template A Reversed pieces

### **From Fabric F, cut:**

four 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Set aside for side borders. sixteen 2-1/2" x WOF strips.  
Subcut:  
eighty-eight Template B pieces  
forty-six 2-1/2" squares  
twenty-four 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles twelve 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles  
seven 3" x WOF strips. Set aside for outer border.

two 5-1/8" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twelve 5-1/8" squares. Cut each once on the diagonal.

one 6" x WOF strip. Subcut:

four 6" x 9" rectangles

one 6-1/4" x WOF strip. Subcut: four 6-1/4" x 9" rectangles

## Quilt Construction

**Step 1:** Sew a Fabric C 2" x 11" strip to either side of a Fabric A panel block.

**Step 2:** Sew a Fabric C 1-1/4" x 12-1/2" strip to the top & bottom of the panel block from Step 1. Repeat Steps 1 & 2 to make eight Fabric A panel blocks and one Fabric B block.

**Step 3:** Sew a Fabric E/Template A and Template A-Reversed to either side of a Fabric F / Template B triangle. Make eighty-eight Arrow Units.



**Arrow Unit - make (88)**

**Step 4:** Sew an Arrow Units to both sides of a Fabric F 2" x 8-1/2" strip. Make (24) Sashing strips.



**Sashing Strip - make (24)**

**Step 5:** Sew together four Fabric F 2-1/2" squares with three Sashing Strips. Make four Sashing Rows.



**Sashing Rows - make (4)**

**Step 6:** Arrange the panel blocks in three rows of three blocks each, and add (12) Sashing Strips (4 per row), following the diagram. Sew each row together.

**Step 7:** Sew the four Sashing Rows together with the three rows: on the top, the bottom, between rows 1 and 2, and between rows 2 and 3.



**Step 8:** Sew together four Arrow Units with three Fabric F 2" x 12-1/2" strips. Make two Side Sashing Strips.




**Side Sashing Strip - make (2)**

**Step 9:** Sew together four Arrow Units with three Fabric F 2" x 12-1/2" strips and two Fabric F 2-1/2" squares. Make two Top/Bottom Sashing Strips.



**Top/Bottom Sashing Strip - make (2)**

**Step 10:** Sew the Side Sashing Strips to the right and left sides of the quilt. Then sew the Top/Bottom Sashing Strips to the top and bottom of the quilt.



**Step 11:** Gather:

Four 2-1/2" Fabric F squares  
Four 2-1/2" Arrow Units from Step  
One 2-1/2" Fabric D square



Arrange in three rows of three as shown, noting the orientation of the Star Points. Sew the units together to form rows, pressing the seam toward the pieced units. Sew the rows together, pressing the seams open.

**Step 12:** Sew one 5-1/8" Fabric F triangle to each of the four edges of the block. Press toward the triangles. The block should measure 9" square.

Repeat Steps 11 and 12 to make a total of six blocks.



**Step 13:** Gather:

three completed Step 12 blocks two 6" x 9" Fabric F rectangles two 6-1/4" x 9" Fabric F rectangles.

Sew together to form the top row of the quilt, placing the 6-1/4" wide rectangles on the ends of the row. Sew it to the top edge of the quilt center.



**Step 14:** Repeat Step 13 to make the bottom row of the quilt and sew it to the bottom edge of the quilt.



**Step 15:** Sew the 1-1/2" Fabric F side border strips together in pairs. Trim to the length of the quilt and sew to the left and right edges of the quilt. Press toward the strips.

**Step 16:** Sew the 1-1/2" Fabric E inner border strips together, end-to end. Trim two lengths to the length of the quilt and sew to the left and right edges of the quilt. Press toward the strips. Trim two lengths to the width of the quilt and sew to the top and bottom edges of the quilt. Press toward the strips.

**Step 17:** Sew the 3" Fabric F outer border strips together, end-to end. Trim two lengths to the length of the quilt and sew to the left and right edges of the quilt. Press toward the strips. Trim two lengths to the width of the quilt and sew to the top and bottom edges of the quilt. Press toward the strips.



**Step 18:** Join the Fabric B binding strips on the short ends with diagonal seams to make a long strip. Press seams in one direction. Press the strip in half along the length with wrong sides together. Bind the quilt edges using your favorite method to complete the quilt.

## Templates

Print at 100%.

Check size printed correctly using 1" box for scale prior to cutting fabric.
