Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 44" wide.

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 44" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

one 34-1/2" x 42-1/2" center panel

From Fabric B, cut:

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 2-1/2" x 42-1/2" side inner borders

two 2-1/2" x 38-1/2" top/bottom inner borders

twenty-four 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric C, cut:

twelve 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

one hundred ninety-two 2-1/2" squares

Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of each square

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips for Binding.

From Fabric D, cut:

four 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twenty-four 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric E, cut:

four 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twenty-four 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric F, cut:

four 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twenty-four 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric G, cut:


seven 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 4-1/2" x 71" side outer borders

two 4-1/2" x 63" top/bottom outer borders

Assemble the Pieced Border

Step 1: Place a Fabric C square right sides together at the left end of a 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric B rectangle, placing the diagonal line as shown. Sew on the marked line. Trim, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press toward the triangle.




Step 2: Repeat Step 1 at the right end of the rectangle, placing the diagonal as shown. Sew, trim and press as before. The finished unit should measure 2-1/2" x 6-1/2".




Repeat with all 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric B, D, E and F rectangles, for a total of ninety-six units.


Step 3: Gather twenty-three completed Step 2 units and sew them together along the longest edge, alternating the colors in this order: Fabric E + Fabric D + Fabric B + Fabric F. Sew together, forming the side pieced border and press the seams to one side. Repeat to make the second side pieced border. Note: The 23rd unit in the strip will be a Fabric B piece.



Step 4: Gather twenty-two completed Step 2 units and sew them together along the longest edge, alternating the colors in this order: Fabric F + Fabric B + Fabric D + Fabric E. Sew together, forming the bottom pieced border and press the seams to one side. Note: The 22nd unit in the strip will be a Fabric B piece.



Step 5: Gather a Fabric F, Fabric E and Fabric D unit. Sew together in that order, as shown. Press the seams to one side. Sew to the end of the completed border from Step 4, noting the fabric placement and orientation. Press.



Step 6: Repeat Steps 4 and 5 to make the top pieced border.

Assemble the Quilt



Step 7: Sew the Fabric B side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric B top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 8: Sew the side pieced borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom pieced borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Note: Pay careful attention to the orientation shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 9: Center and stitch a 4-1/2" x 71" Fabric G strip to the long sides of the quilt center, beginning, ending and securing 1/4" from the corners of the quilt center. Repeat with the 4-1/2" x 63" strips on the top and bottom. Miter corners using your favorite method, checking to be sure that the stripe matches and all corners lie flat. Trim mitered corner seams to 1/4" and press open to complete the quilt top. Press Fabric G seams toward the strips.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
