## Fabric and Supplies Needed

*Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.*

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## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

### **Luminous Stars Colorstory**

#### **From Fabric A, fussy cut:**

one 34-1/2" x 42-1/2" center panel

#### **From Fabric B, cut:**

two 9-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

four 9-1/2" x 10" rectangles

four 9-1/2" x 5" rectangles

six 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

four 6-1/2" x 8" rectangles

four 6-1/2" x 10" rectangles

sixteen 6-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangles

four 4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

thirty-two 4" squares for the large HSTs

seven 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

eighty 3-1/2" squares

two 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twenty-four 3" squares for the small HST

four 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

sixty 2-1/2" squares

thirteen 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 2" x 36-1/2" strips

Sew the remaining strips together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 2" x 73-1/2" top/bottom outer borders

two 2" x 84-1/2" side outer borders

two 2" x 55-1/2" strips

#### **From Fabric C, cut:**

four 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 1-1/2" x 34-1/2" top/bottom inner borders

two 1-1/2" x 44-1/2" side inner borders

#### **From Fabric D, cut:**

four 4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

thirty-two 4" squares for the large HSTs

#### **From Fabric E, cut:**

five 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 2-1/2" x 36-1/2" top/bottom middle borders

two 2-1/2" x 48-1/2" side middle borders

two 3" x WOF strip. Subcut:

twenty-four 3" squares for the small HSTs

#### **From the Binding Fabric, cut:**

nine 2-1/2" x WOF strips

## Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

**Step 1:** Pair a 4" Fabric B square with a 4" Fabric D square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 3-1/2" square. Repeat to make sixty-four B/D HSTs.




**Step 2:** Pair a 3" Fabric B square with a 3" Fabric E square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 2-1/2" square. Repeat to make forty-eight B/E HSTs.



## Assemble the Large Star Blocks

**Step 3:** Gather:  
four large HSTs  
five 3-1/2" Fabric B squares


Arrange in three rows of three, noting the orientation of the HSTs. Sew the squares together to form rows, pressing the seams away from the HSTs. Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side. The block should measure 9-1/2" square. Repeat to make sixteen Large Star Blocks.



## Assemble the Small Star Blocks

**Step 4:** Gather:  
four small matching HSTs  
five 2-1/2" Fabric B squares

Arrange in three rows of three, noting the orientation of the HSTs. Sew the square together to form rows, pressing the seams away from the HSTs. Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side. The block should measure 6-1/2" square. Repeat to make twelve Small Star Blocks.



## Assemble the Quilt Center

**Step 5:** Sew the Fabric C top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric C side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 6:** Sew the Fabric E top and bottom middle borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric E side middle borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.



## Assemble the Small Star Borders

### Step 7: Gather:

three Small Star Blocks from Fabric E  
two 6-1/2" x 9-1/2" Fabric B rectangles  
two 6-1/2" x 8" Fabric B rectangles  
one 2" x 36-1/2" Fabric B strip

Arrange as shown and sew together to form a side Small Star Border. Press seams away from the Star Blocks. Repeat to make a second side border. Sew to the left and right edges of the quilt center. Press.



### Step 8: Gather:

three Small Star Blocks from Fabric E  
two 6-1/2" x 9-1/2" Fabric B rectangles  
two 6-1/2" x 10" Fabric B rectangles  
one 2" x 55-1/2" Fabric B strip

Arrange as shown and sew together to form a top/bottom Small Star Border. Press seams away from the Star Blocks. Repeat to make a second border. Sew to the top and bottom edges of the quilt center. Press.



## Assemble the Large Star Borders

### Step 9: Gather:

four Large Star Blocks

three 6-1/2" x 9-1/2" Fabric B rectangles two 9-1/2" x 5" Fabric B rectangles


Arrange as shown and sew together to form a side Large Star Border. Press seams away from the Star Blocks. Repeat to make a second side border. Sew to the left and right edges of the quilt center. Press.

### Step 10: Gather:

four Large Star Blocks

three 6-1/2" x 9-1/2" Fabric B rectangles two 9-1/2" x 10" Fabric B rectangles

Arrange as shown and sew together to form a top/bottom Large Star Border. Press seams away from the Star Blocks. Repeat to make a second border. Sew to the top and bottom edges of the quilt center. Press.



**Step 11:** Sew the Fabric B top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric B side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
