Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A:

Fussy cut the border strips away from the center panel, about 1/4" outside the solid green borders to 5", then subcut:

four 5" squares

two 5" x 10-1/2" rectangles

Fussy cut the center panel to 22-1/2" x 33-1/2"

From Fabric B, cut:

ten 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 2" x 25-1/2" strips top/bottom inner border pieces

two 2" x 37-1/2" strips top/bottom middle border pieces

two 2" x 33-1/2" side inner border pieces

three 2" x WOF strips; join short ends together with diagonal seams; cut into:

two 2" x 45-1/2" side middle border pieces

twelve 2" x 5" rectangles

From Fabric C, cut:

three 2" x WOF strips. Set aside for strip piecing.

two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 4-1/2" x 37-1/2" top/bottom outer border strips

four 4-1/2" x WOF strips; join short ends together with diagonal seams; cut into:

two 4-1/2" x 56-1/2" side border outer strips

From Fabric D, cut:

six 2" x WOF strips. Set aside for strip piecing.

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

six 2-1/2" x WOF strips


Assemble the Strip Pieced Units

Step 1: Sew a Fabric C strip between two Fabric D strips, along the longest edge. Press toward the darker fabric. Repeat to make three strip sets.

Step 2: Cut the strip sets into:

four 5" x 10-1/2" units

two 5" x 22-1/2" units



Assemble the Quilt

Step 3: Sew the Fabric B side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric B top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 4: Sew a 2" x 5" Fabric B piece to each end of a 22-1/2" long strip unit set. Press toward the Fabric B pieces. Repeat to make a second unit like this. Sew to the top and bottom edges of the quilt center. Press.



Step 5: Gather:

- two Fabric A border print squares
- one Fabric A border print rectangle
- four 2" x 5" Fabric B rectangles
- two 5" x 10-1/2" strip set units

Arrange as shown. Sew together to form a column. Press toward the Fabric B pieces. Repeat to make a second column. Sew to the left and right edges of the quilt center.

Step 6: Sew the Fabric B side middle borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric B top and bottom middle borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 7: Sew the Fabric C top and bottom middle borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric C side middle borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
