Fabric Requirements and Cutting Guide

(Note: "wof" means width of fabric)

Fabric A 4729-0122 1 panel Center and trim panel to measure approximately 22-1/2" x 40-1/2"

Fabric B 4730-0122 1-1/2 yards

Cut borders down the center line of the narrow blue band separating the hearts between the printed strips. Cut (2) borders with darker blue background and floating snowflakes, cut (2) borders with light blue backgrounds and stars. Cut all borders the full length of yardage

Fabric C 4731-0122 1/2 yard

Cut (4) 3" x wof strips, for borders, sew together end-to-end for borders

Fabric D 4731-0190 1/3 yard

Cut (2) 5-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (8) 5-1/2" squares

Fabric E 4732-0122 1/8 yard

Cut (2) appliqué bird shapes, and 2 bird shapes in reverse using template provided

Fabric F 4735-0190 1/8 yard

Cut (6) appliqué star shapes using template provided

Fabric G 4736-0171 1/8 yard

Cut (8) appliqué heart shapes using template provided

Fabric H 4736-0122 3/4 yard

Cut (2) 5-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (10) 5-1/2" squares

Cut (5) 2-1/4" x wof strips, sew together end-to-end for binding

Backing 4733-0122 3 yards

Cut one piece 66" long. Cut remainder of backing fabric in half on the length of fabric from top to bottom; then sew into one long piece matching the fabric pattern, press joining seam open. Sew to the 66" long backing matching patterns again to complete backing.

Supplies

Fusible web for appliqué (optional)

Thread in colors to match the appliqué stars, hearts and birds

Instructions

1. Measure the long sides of the Fabric A center panel and cut (2) fabric C 3" wide borders to size. Join to opposite sides of the panel. Measure the top/bottom of the panel and cut (2) Fabric C 3" wide borders to size. Join to top/bottom of the center panel. Press seams. Center the bordered Fabric A panel and trim the panel with added borders to 26-1/2" x 45-1/2".
2. Appliqué blocks: Referring to the block diagrams, use your favorite appliqué method to appliqué the blocks. Appliqué 6 Fabric F stars to 6 fabric H background squares. Appliqué 2 birds facing right and 2 birds facing left to the remaining 4 Fabric H background squares. Appliqué the 8 Fabric G hearts to (8) Fabric D background squares.
3. Sew the appliqué blocks into (2) vertical borders alternating them in the order shown in the quilt assembly diagram. Join the appliqué borders to opposite sides of the bordered center panel.
4. Center and trim the narrow Fabric B borders to 45-1/2" long. Join these borders to opposite sides of the appliqué borders.
5. Measure the quilt from side to side across the middle then trim the wide Fabric B borders to this measurement (approximately 46-1/2"). Join these borders to the top and bottom of the quilt.
6. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt the layers together. Bind to finish the outside edges.
