

Arctic Wolf Pups

Quilt Designed by eQuilter



50" x 64"

Skill Level: Intermediate

Finished Quilt Size: 50" x 64"

*Please read all instructions before beginning.
Pre-washing NOT recommended for fabrics.*

Yardages and Cutting

*WOF is 42" width of fabric from selvedge edge to selvedge edge.
Remove as little fabric as possible when squaring strip ends.*

1 Silver Moon Wolves panel

- Trim panel to 26 1/2" x 40 1/2", centering the image.

1 yard snow print

- 3 strips 8 1/4" x WOF; cut into (12) 8 1/4" squares. Cut each square diagonally in half twice to make a total of (48) triangles (You will only need 44 for this project).

1 yards blue tonal

- 2 strips 8 1/4" x WOF; cut into (9) 8 1/4" squares. Cut each square diagonally in half twice to make a total of (36) triangles.
- 1 strip 4" x WOF; cut into (8) 4" squares.
- 1 strip 4 3/8" x WOF; cut into (8) 4 3/8" squares. Cut each square diagonally in half once to make a total of (16) triangles.

3/4 yard gray tonal print

- 7 strips 2 1/4" x WOF for binding.

1 1/4 yard brown tonal

- 4 strips 1 1/2" x WOF; trim to 2 strips each, 28 1/2" and 40 1/2" for panel framing.
- 6 strips 4 1/2" x WOF for outer border.

3 3/4 yards of 42" backing fabric OR

4 1/2 yards of 42" directional backing fabric

- 2 strips 65" x WOF OR
- 2 strips 79" x WOF for directional backing

OR

2 yards wide backing fabric

- 1 piece 65" x 79"

Batting:

- 1 piece 65" x 79"

Piecing the Borders

Use a 1/4" seam allowance for all stitching. Press seams as directed.

1. Sew (4) snow print 8 1/4" triangles together with (3) blue tonal 8 1/4" triangles as shown below, being careful not to stretch the seams. Press seams toward the darker print. Sew 4 3/8" blue tonal triangles to the right and left end of the strip. Press seams toward the triangles. Sew 4" blue tonal squares to the left and right ends of the strip to complete the 4" x 35 1/2" Top/Bottom Inner Border. Press seams toward the square. Repeat to make a second Top/Bottom Inner Border.



Top/Bottom Inner Border - Make 2

2. Sew (5) snow print 8 1/4" triangles together with (4) blue tonal 8 1/4" triangles as shown below, being careful not to stretch the seams. Press seams toward the darker print. Sew 4 3/8" blue tonal triangles to the right and left end of the strip. Press seams toward the triangles. Sew 4" blue tonal squares to the left and right ends of the strip to complete the 4" x 42 1/2" Top/Bottom Outer Border. Press seams toward the square. Repeat to make a second Top/Bottom Outer Border.



Top/Bottom Outer Border - Make 2

3. Sew (6) snow print 8 1/4" triangles together with (5) blue tonal 8 1/4" triangles as shown below, being careful not to stretch the seams. Press seams toward the darker print. Sew 4 3/8" blue tonal triangles to the right and left end of the strip to complete the 4" x 42 1/2" Side Inner Border. Press seams toward the triangles. Repeat to make a second Side Inner Border.



Side Inner Border - Make 2

4. Sew (7) snow print 8 1/4" triangles together with (6) blue tonal 8 1/4" triangles as shown below, being careful not to stretch the seams. Press seams toward the darker print. Sew 4 3/8" blue tonal triangles to the right and left end of the strip to complete the 4" x 49 1/2" Side Outer Border. Press seams toward the triangles. Repeat to make a second Side Outer Border.

Finishing the Quilt

1. Sew the 1 1/2" x 40 1/2" brown tonal strip to the long sides of the panel and the 1 1/2" x 28 1/2" brown tonal strips to the top and bottom to complete the 28 1/2" x 42 1/2" framed panel. Press seams toward the strips.
2. Being careful with the orientation, stitch the Side Inner Borders to the sides of the framed panel, and the Top/Bottom Inner Borders to the top and bottom of the framed panel. Press seams toward the panel.
3. Being careful with the orientation, stitch the Side Outer Borders to the sides of the framed panel, and the Top/Bottom Outer Borders to the top and bottom of the framed panel. Press seams toward the center panel.
4. Stitch the 4 1/2" x WOF brown tonal strips short ends together, making one long strip. Cut into (2) strips each 56 1/2" and 50 1/2". Sew the longer strips to the sides of the quilt center, and the shorter strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center to complete the quilt top. Press border seams toward the border strips.
5. If using 42" backing fabric, remove the selvedge edges from the backing pieces. Join the pieces on the long edges with a 1/2" seam allowance. Press seam open. Trim to make the 65" x 79" backing piece.
6. Layer the quilt top with the backing and batting pieces. Quilt as desired. Trim batting and backing even with the top.
7. Join the gray tonal print binding strips on the short ends with diagonal seams to make a long strip. Press seams in one direction. Press the strip in half along the length with wrong sides together. Bind the quilt edges using your favorite method to complete the quilt.
