

Aussie Pup

Quilt Designed by eQuilter



60" x 60"

Skill Level: Intermediate

Finished Quilt Size: 60" x 60"

Please read all instructions before beginning. Pre-washing recommended for hand dyes only. Pre-washing NOT recommended for other fabrics.

Yardages and Cutting

WOF is 42" width of fabric from selvage edge to selvage edge. Remove as little fabric as possible when squaring strip ends.

1 Aussie Pup panel

- Trim to 42 1/2" square.

5/8 yard brown hand dye

- 3 strips 5 7/8" x WOF; cut into (20) 5 7/8" squares, then cut in half diagonally to make 40 triangles.

1/2 yard denim hand dye

1/2 yard tan hand dye

From each fabric, cut the following:

- 2 strips 6 1/4" x WOF; cut into (10) 6 1/4" squares, then cut twice diagonally to make 40 triangles.

1 yards white tonal

- 6 strips 3" x WOF for border.
- 5 strips 2" x WOF for panel framing.

5/8 yard bright blue hand dye

- 7 strips 2 1/4" x WOF for binding.

4 1/3 yards of 42" backing fabric OR

- 2 strips 76" x WOF

OR

2 1/4 yards wide backing fabric

- 1 piece 76" x 76"

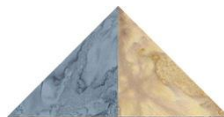
Batting

- 1 piece 76" x 76"

Piecing the Units

Use a 1/4" seam allowance for all stitching. Press seams as directed.

1. Sew a tan triangle to 1 short edge of each denim triangle to make (40) 5 7/8" x 5 7/8" x 8 3/8" pieced triangles. Press seam to the denim side.

2. Stitch a brown triangle to each pieced triangle to make (40) 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" triangle units. Press seam to the brown side.

Completing the Quilt

Refer to the exploded quilt diagram on the next page throughout the following steps.

1. Sew the 2" x WOF white strips short ends together to make a long strip. Press seams to one side. Cut into 2 strips each 45 1/2" and 42 1/2". Stitch the shorter strips to the sides of the panel and the longer strips to the top and bottom. Press seams toward the strips.

2. Join 9 triangle units on the denim and brown edges to make a 5 1/2" x 45 1/2" side strip. Press seams to one side. Repeat to make a second side strip. Stitch the strips to the sides of the framed panel. Press seams toward the framed panel.

3. Join 11 triangle units on the tan and brown edges to make the 5 1/2" x 55 1/2" top strip. Press seams to one side. Repeat to make the bottom strip. Sew the strips to the top and bottom of the panel section to complete the 55 1/2" x 55 1/2" quilt center. Press seams toward the panel section.

4. Repeat step 1 with the 3" x WOF white strips to complete the top, cutting 2 strips each 55 1/2" and 60 1/2".

5. If using 42" backing fabric, remove the selvage edges from the backing pieces. Join the pieces on the long edges with a 1/2" seam allowance. Press seam open. Trim to make the 76" x 76" backing piece.

6. Layer the quilt top with the backing and batting pieces. Quilt as desired. Trim batting and backing even with the top.

7. Join the bright blue hand-dye binding strips on the short ends with diagonal seams to make a long strip. Press seams in one direction. Press the strip in half along the length with wrong sides together. Bind the quilt edges using your favorite method to complete the quilt.
