# Kitten Lullaby

### Quilt Designed by eQuilter



Skill Level: Confident Beginner Finished Quilt Size: 62" x 54"

Please read all instructions before beginning. Pre-washing NOT recommended.

## Yardages and Cutting


WOF is width of fabric from selvage edge to selvage edge. Remove as little fabric as possible when removing selvages and squaring strip ends.

#### **Kitten Lullaby panel**

• Trim to 42 1/2" x 28 1/2".

#### 2 yards border stripe

- Fussy-cut (2) strips 6 1/2" x WOF, centering on the moons. Trim to 31 1/2".
- Fussy-cut (2) strips 9 1/2" x WOF, beginning 3/4" below the top starry edge, then cutting 9 1/2" down from there as shown. Trim to 57 1/2".



#### 5/8 yard galaxy print

• 7 strips 2 1/4" x WOF for binding.

#### 1 yard black

- 4 strips 2" x WOF; trim to 2 strips each 42 1/2" and 31 1/2" for panel framing.
- 6 strips 3" x WOF for border.

#### 4 yards 44/45" backing fabric

• 2 strips 69" x WOF for directional fabric

#### OR

#### 2 yards wide backing fabric

• 1 piece 77" x 69"

#### **Batting**

• 1 piece 77" x 69"

### **Completing the Quilt**

Use a 1/4" seam allowance for all stitching. Press seams as directed. Refer to the exploded quilt diagram as needed.

- 1. Sew the 2" x 42 1/2" black strips to the top and bottom of the panel. Press seams toward the strips. Stitch the 2" x 31 1/2" black strips to the sides to complete the 45 1/2" x 31 1/2" framed panel. Press seams toward the strips.
- 2. Sew the 6 1/2" x 31 1/2" border stripe strips to the sides of the framed panel. Press seams toward the border strips. Repeat with 6 1/2" x 57 1/2" strips on the top and bottom.
- 3. Sew the 3" x WOF black strips short ends together to make a long strip. Press seams to one side. Cut into 2 strips each 62 1/2" and 49 1/2". Stitch the shorter strips to the sides of the bordered center and the longer strips to the top and bottom to complete the top. Press seams toward the strips.
- 4. If using 44/45" backing fabric, remove the selvage edges from the backing pieces. Join the pieces on the long edges with a 1/2" seam allowance. Press seam open. Trim to make the 77" x 69" backing piece.
- 5. Layer the quilt top with the backing and batting pieces. Quilt as desired. Trim batting and backing even with the top.
- 6. Join the galaxy print binding strips on the short ends with diagonal seams to make a long strip. Press seams open. Press the strip in half along the length with wrong sides together.
  - 7. Bind the quilt edges using your favorite method to complete the quilt.
