## Fox Family Love

## Quilt Designed by eQuilter



56" x 56"

Please read all instructions before beginning. Pre-washing NOT recommended.

## Yardages and Cutting

WOF is width of fabric from selvage edge to selvage edge. Remove as little fabric as possible when removing selvages and squaring strip ends.

## Fox Family panel

- Trim to $341 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide x $341 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ tall.


## 5/8 yard rust texture

- 1 strip $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF; cut into (4) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares and (8) $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
- 4 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF; trim to 2 each $381 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and 34 1/2" strips.


## 3/4 yard brown texture

- 6 strips $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF for border.


## 1 yard light gray fur

- 1 strip $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF; cut into (8) $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares and (4) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
- 8 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF; trim to $381 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ for border units.

4 yards 44/45" backing fabric

- 2 strips 71" x WOF

OR
2 yards wide backing fabric

- 1 piece 71" x 71"


## 1 yard gold texture

- 4 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF; trim to $381 / 2^{\prime \prime}$


## Batting

- 1 piece $71^{\prime \prime} \times 71^{\prime \prime}$
- 6 strips $21 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF for binding.


## Piecing the Blocks

Use a 1/4" seam allowance for all stitching. Press seams as directed.

1. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ fur squares.
2. Place a marked square right sides together with a $27 / 8$ " rust square. Sew $1 / 4$ " out on each side of the line. Cut apart on the line. Press the units open with seam allowances to the rust side to make (2) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ triangle units. Repeat to make 16 units.


Triangle Units - Make 16
3. Join 2 triangle units to make a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ A strip. Press seam to the rust side. Repeat to make 4 A strips. Repeat to make 4 B strips, changing positioning of the triangle units as shown.

4. Referring to the diagrams on the next page, stitch an A strip to 1 side of a $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rust square to make a $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ row. Press seam toward the square. Sew a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ fur square to the rust end of a B strip to make a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ row. Press seam toward the square. Join the rows to complete (1) $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Paw block. Press seam toward the bottom row. Repeat to make 4 blocks.


## Completing the Quilt

1. Sew the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 341 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rust strips to the sides of the panel. Press seams toward the strips. Stitch the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 381 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the top and bottom to complete the $381 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 381 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ framed panel. Press seams toward the strips.
2. Sew $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 381 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ gold strips lengthwise between (2) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 381 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ fur strips to make a $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 381 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ border unit. Press seams toward the fur strips. Repeat to make (4) border units. Stitch (2) border units to the sides of the framed panel. Press seams toward the border units.
3. Sew a Paw block to each end of the remaining (2) border units to complete the $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x $501 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top and bottom border. Press seams away from the blocks.
4. Stitch the borders to the top and bottom of the framed panel to complete the $501 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 50$ $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ quilt center. Press seams toward the strips.
5. Sew the $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF brown texture strips short ends together to make a long strip. Press seams to one side. Cut into 2 strips each $561 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and $501 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Sew the $501 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the sides of the quilt center and the $561 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the top and bottom to complete the top. Press seams toward the strips.
6. If using 42" backing fabric, remove the selvage edges from the backing pieces. Join the pieces on the long edges with a $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance. Press seam open. Trim to make the $71^{\prime \prime} \times 71^{\prime \prime}$ backing piece.
7. Layer the quilt top with the backing and batting pieces. Quilt as desired. Trim batting and backing even with the top.
8. Join the gold binding strips on the short ends with diagonal seams to make a long strip. Press seams in one direction. Press the strip in half along the length with wrong sides together.
9. Bind the quilt edges using your favorite method to complete the quilt.
