Skill Level: Confident Beginner Finished Quilt Size: 54" x 54"

Please read all instructions before beginning. Pre-washing NOT recommended.

Yardages and Cutting

WOF is width of fabric from selvage edge to selvage edge. LOF is length of fabric, parallel to the selvage edges. Remove as little fabric as possible when removing selvages and squaring strip ends.

1 1/4 yard Jazz Musicians

• Fussy cut a 21 1/2" x 21 1/2" square, centering on a set of musicians.

1/2 yard Instruments allover

• Fussy-cut (4) 8" squares, centering an instrument in each.

1/3 yard white tonal

• 4 strips 2" x WOF; trim to (2) strips each 24 1/2" and 21 1/2".

3/4 yard music curls

• 4 strips 5" x WOF; trim to (2) strips each 33 1/2" and 24 1/2".

1 yards piano keys

• Cut 4 strips 6" x LOF, centering on a row of piano keys in each. Trim to (4) strips 33 1/2".

1 1/4 yard black solid

- 6 strips 3 1/2" x WOF for outer border.
- 8 strips 1 1/2" x WOF; trim to (4) strips 1 1/2" x 33 1/2".

5/8 yard multi dots print

• 6 strips 2 1/4" x WOF for binding

4 yards 44/45" backing fabric

• 2 strips 69" x WOF

OR

2 yards wide backing fabric

• 1 piece 69" x 69"

Batting

• 1 piece 69" x 69"

Completing the Quilt

Use a 1/4" seam allowance for all stitching. Press seams as directed. Refer to the exploded quilt diagram as needed.

- 1. Stitch the 2" \times 21 1/2" white tonal strips to the sides of the panel and 2" \times 24 1/2" white tonal strips to the top and bottom. Press seams toward the strips. Press seams toward the panel.
- 2. Stitch the 5" x 24 1/2" music curls strips to the sides of the panel and the 5" x 33 1/2" music curls strips to the top and bottom of the panel. Press seams toward the strips.
- 3. Sew 1 1/2" x 33 1/2" black strips to both long sides of a piano keys strip to make a piano key unit. Press seams toward the black strips. Repeat to make (4) piano key units.
 - 4. Stitch (2) piano key units to the sides of the panel. Press seams toward the units.
- 5. Sew 8" instrument squares two both ends of the remaining (2) piano key units to make instrument rows. Press seams toward the instruments. Then stitch the instrument rows to the top and bottom of the panel. Press seams toward the rows.
- 6. Sew the 3 1/2" x WOF black strips short ends together to make a long strip. Press seams to one side. Cut into (2) strips each, 54 1/2" and 48 1/2". Stitch the 3 1/2" x 48 1/2" strips to the sides of the panel and the 3 1/2" x 54 1/2" strips to the top and bottom of the panel to complete the top. Press seams toward the strips.
- 7. If using 44/45" backing fabric, remove the selvage edges from the backing pieces. Join the pieces on the long edges with a 1/2" seam allowance. Press seam open. Trim to make the 69" x 69" backing piece.

- 8. Layer the quilt top with the backing and batting pieces. Quilt as desired. Trim batting and backing even with the top.
- 9. Join the multi dots print binding strips on the short ends with diagonal seams to make a long strip. Press seams open. Press the strip in half along the length with wrong sides together.
 - 10. Bind the quilt edges using your favorite method to complete the quilt.
