Finished quilt size: 40" x 58"

Fabric Requirements

- 1 panel ($\frac{2}{3}$ yard) Pavilion-C6322 Turquoise
- $\frac{2}{3}$ yard Pavilion-C6323 Bright
- $\frac{5}{8}$ yard Pavilion-C6327 Black
- $\frac{1}{4}$ yard Kim-C6100 Citrus
- $\frac{3}{4}$ yard Kim-C6100 Orange (includes $\frac{1}{2}$ yard for binding)
- $2\frac{2}{3}$ yards Butterfly Pavilion backing of your choice
- 48" x 66" batting

Cutting

From Pavilion-C6322 Turquoise:

- Trim the panel to $22\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ ".

From Pavilion-C6323 Bright:

- Cut five $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x width-of-fabric (WOF) strips for border 2.

From Pavilion-C6327 Black:

- Cut five $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for border 4.

From Kim-C6100 Citrus:

- Cut four $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for border 1. Sub-cut two $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and two $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $24\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From Kim-C6100 Orange:

- Cut five $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for border 3.
- Cut six $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for binding.

Quilt Top Assembly

All seam allowances are $\frac{1}{4}$ " and pieces are sewn right sides together.

1. Sew one $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ " C6100 Citrus strip to each side of the panel.
2. Sew one $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $24\frac{1}{2}$ " C6100 Citrus strip to the top and the other to the bottom.

3. Sew the three $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF C6323 Bright strips together end to end. Measure the quilt center length and cut two C6323 Bright strips that measurement. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt.
4. Measure the quilt center width and cut two C6323 Bright strips that measurement. Sew one strip to the top and the other to the bottom of the quilt.
5. Repeat steps 3-4 using $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF C6100 Orange strips for border 3.
6. Repeat steps 3-4 using $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF C6327 Black strips for border 4.

Finishing

7. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing, and quilt as desired.
8. Stitch the binding strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Fold and press the resulting long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Stitch to the quilt front, matching raw edges and mitering the corners.
9. Fold the binding to the quilt underside and hand-stitch the folded edge to the quilt back.
