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Finished quilt size: 40½" x 59½"

Fabric Requirements

One panel (2/3 yard) Plume-C4663 Peacock
1 yard Ombre-C4700 Peacock
1 yard Plume-C4666 Peacock
1/2 yard Studio-C3096 Peacock (binding)
2 3/4 yards Plume backing fabric of your choice

Other Supplies:

49" x 68" batting
Paper-back fusible web

Cutting

From Plume-C4663 Peacock:

- Trim panel to 23" x 42".

From Ombre-C4700 Peacock:

- Cut twelve 2 1/4" x width-of-fabric (WOF) strips for inner borders.
- Save the remaining fabric for the petal appliqués.

From Plume-C4666 Peacock:

- Cut six 4" x WOF for outside borders.
- Cut one 5 3/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut four 5 3/4" squares.


From Studio-C3096 Peacock:

- Cut six 2 1/2" x WOF for binding.

Quilt Top Assembly

1. Sew three 2 1/4" x WOF C4700 Peacock strips together on the long edges, alternating the direction of the center strip for emphatic color change. Repeat to make four strip sets.
2. Trim two Ombre strip sets to 42". Referring to the quilt photo for color placement, sew one set to each side of the panel. Trim the two remaining Ombre sets to 23", referring to the quilt photo for color positioning.
3. Trace twelve petal shapes onto the paper side of the fusible web using the Petal Template. Rough-cut around each petal, leaving 1/8" outside the drawn lines. Following the manufacturer's instructions, fuse the petals to the wrong side of the C4700 Peacock fabric in variously colored areas. Cut out the petals on the drawn lines.
4. Fuse three petals of various shades to each of the four 5 3/4" C4666 Peacock

squares. (Figure 1) Stitch around the shapes using a zigzag, satin or decorative machine stitch.

5. Referring to the quilt photo for orientation, sew one 5 3/4" appliquéd square to each end of the 23" Ombre strip sets.
6. Sew one Ombre set to the top and another to the bottom of the center panel, noting the petal orientation.
7. Sew six 4" x WOF C4666 Peacock strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the quilt center length and cut two strips that measurement. Sew one 4" strip to each side of the quilt top.
8. Measure the quilt center width and cut two strips that measurement. Sew one strip to the top and the other to the bottom of the quilt top.

Mosaic Plume Petal Template

This square should measure 1" x 1" when printed.

Note: Turn off "page scaling" or "fit to page" in your print dialog box to insure that the template prints at actual size.

Finishing

9. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing and quilt as desired.
10. Stitch the binding strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Fold and press the resulting long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Stitch to the quilt front, matching raw edges and mitering the corners.
11. Fold the binding to the quilt underside and hand-stitch the folded edge to the quilt back.

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
