## Out of this World

## Quilt Designed by eQuilter



53" x 53"

Please read all instructions before beginning. Pre-washing NOT recommended.

## Yardages and Cutting

WOF is width of fabric from selvage edge to selvage edge. Remove as little fabric as possible when trimming selvages and squaring strip ends.

## Out of this World panel

-Trim to $221 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x $401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

## $1 \mathbf{1 / 2}$ yards planet print

- Fussy-cut (4) $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares, centering the same planet in each square for the corner blocks.
- From the remainder, fussy-cut (6) $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares, centering a planet of your choice in each, for the on-point units.


## 3/4 yard blue marble

- 5 strips $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF for border.


## 5/8 yard multicolor ribbons

- 6 strips $21 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF for binding.


## 1 yard black dot

- 3 strips $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF; cut into (24) $41 / 2^{\text {" squares. }}$
- 3 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF for center border.
- 4 strips $2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF; trim to $401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ for center border and sashing.


## 4 yards of 44/45' backing fabric

- 2 pieces 69" x WOF

OR
2 yards wide backing fabric

- 1 piece 69 " x $69 "$


## Batting

- 1 piece $69^{\prime \prime}$ x 69"


## 1/4 yard orange marble

- 5 strips 1" x WOF for border.


## Completing the Quilt

Use a 1/4" seam allowance for all stitching. Press all seams as directed. Refer to the exploded quilt diagram on the next page throughout the following steps.

1. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ black dot squares.
2. Place marked squares right sides together on the top left and bottom right corners of the 6 planet squares. Sew on the lines. Trim seam allowance $1 / 4$ " out from the stitching. Press the triangles open with seam allowance toward the center square. Repeat on the remaining corners of each square to complete (6) $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ on-point units except press seams toward the triangles.

3. Sew (2) of the $2^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ black dot strips to the sides of the panel rectangle. Press seams toward the strips.
4. Stitch 3 on-point units top to bottom to make an $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 241 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip, turning the units to offset seam allowances. Press seams open between the units. Add planet corner blocks to the top and bottom to complete an $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side strip. Press seams toward the corner squares. Repeat to make a second side strip. Sew to the sides of the bordered panel to complete the $401 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ panel section. Press seams toward the bordered panel.
5. Sew the remaining (2) 2 " $x 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ black dot strips to the sides of the panel section. Press seams toward the strips.
6. Stitch the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF black dot strips short ends together to make a long strip. Press seams to one side. Cut into (2) $441 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Sew to the top and bottom of the panel section to complete the $441 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 441 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ quilt center. Press seams toward the strips.
7. Repeat step 6 with the $1^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ WOF orange marble strips to make a long strip, cutting 2 strips each $451 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and $441 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Stitch the shorter strips to the sides of the quilt center and the longer strips to the top and bottom. Press seams toward the strips.
8. Repeat with the $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ WOF blue marble strips to complete the top, cutting 2 strips each $531 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and $451 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
9. If using $44 / 45$ " backing fabric, remove the selvage edges from the backing pieces. Join the pieces on the long edges with a $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance. Press seam open. Trim to make the $69{ }^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ $69 "$ backing piece.
10. Layer the top with the backing and batting pieces. Quilt as desired. Trim batting and backing even with the top.
11. Join the multicolor ribbons binding strips on the short ends with diagonal seams to make a long strip. Press seams in one direction. Press the strip in half along the length with wrong sides together. Bind the quilt edges using your favorite method to complete the quilt.
