## Luminous Tree

Quilt Designed by eQuilter


46" x 64"

Please read all instructions before beginning. Pre-washing recommended for hand dye only. Pre-washing NOT recommended for other fabrics.

## Yardages and Cutting

WOF is width of fabric from selvage edge to selvage edge. Remove as little fabric as possible when trimming selvages and squaring strip ends.

## Luminous panel

- Trim to 22 1/2" x 40 1/2".


## 1 1/2 yards border stripe

- Fussy-cut (4) $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ LOF strips, first cutting $3 / 8$ " below the aqua flower and then cutting over from there as shown. Trim to 2 strips each $491 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and $311 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.



## 1/2 yard large floral

- Fussy-cut (4) 5 1/2" squares, centered on a flower.


## 1/2 yard medium floral

## 1 1/4 yard black

- 4 strip 2 1/2" x WOF; cut into (2) 2 1/2" x 41 1/2" strips and (2) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 261 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- 4 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF.
- 5 strips 3 " x WOF for outer border.


## 3/4 yard gold solid

- 4 strip 1" x WOF for panel framing.
- 7 strips $21 / 4$ x WOF for binding.


## 3 1/2 yards of 44/45' backing fabric OR

$41 / 2$ yards directional backing fabric

- 2 pieces $61^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF OR
- 2 pieces 79" x WOF directional fabric

OR
$13 / 4$ yards wide backing fabric

- 1 piece 61" x 79"


## Batting

- Fussy-cut (4) 3" squares, centered on a flower.


## Piecing the Blocks

Use a 1/4" seam allowance for all stitching. Press seams as directed.

1. Stitch the (2) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 411 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ black strips to the sides of the panel and the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 261 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ black strips to the top and bottom. Press seams toward the strips.
2. Sew the (4) 1 " x WOF gold strips short ends together to make a long strip. Press seams to one side. Cut into (2) $441 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and (2) $271 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
3. Stitch the $1^{\prime \prime} \times 441 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ gold strips to the sides of the panel and the $1 " \times 271 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ gold strips to the top and bottom of the panel. Press seams toward the panel.
4. Sew the (4) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF black strips short ends together to make a long strip. Press seams to one side. Cut into (2) $451 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and (2) $311 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
5. Stitch the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 451 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ black strips to the sides of the panel and the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 311 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ black strips to the top and bottom of the panel. Press seams toward the panel.
6. Sew (2) $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ large floral squares to the left and right sides of a $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 311 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ border stripe to make a top border strip, as shown in the exploded diagram. Press seams toward the strips. Repeat to make a bottom border strip.
7. Stitch the $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 491 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ border strips to the left and right sides of the panel. Then sew the top and bottom border strips to the top and bottom to complete the $411 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 591 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ panel center.
8. Sew the (5) 3" x WOF black strips short ends together to make a long strip. Press seams to one side. Cut into (2) strips $591 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and (2) strips $411 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
9. Sew (2) $3^{\prime \prime}$ medium floral squares to the left and right sides of a 3 " x $411 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ black strip to make an outer top border strip, as shown in the exploded diagram. Press seams toward the strips. Repeat to make an outer bottom border strip.
10. Stitch the $3 " \mathrm{x} 591 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ black strips to the left and right sides of the panel. Then sew the outer top and outer bottom border strips to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.
11. If using $44 / 45$ " backing fabric, remove the selvage edges from the backing pieces. Join the pieces on the long edges with a $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance. Press seam open. Trim to make the $61^{\prime \prime} \times 79^{\prime \prime}$ backing piece.
12. Layer the top with the backing and batting pieces. Quilt as desired. Trim batting and backing even with the top.
13. Join the gold solid binding strips on the short ends with diagonal seams to make a long strip. Press seams in one direction. Press the strip in half along the length with wrong sides together. Bind the quilt edges using your favorite method to complete the quilt.
