

# Reverie Garden

Quilt Designed by eQuilter



60" x 64"

**Skill Level:** Confident Beginner

**Finished Quilt Size:** 60" x 64"

*Please read all instructions before beginning.*

*Pre-washing recommended for hand dye and solid only. Pre-washing not recommended for other fabrics.*

## Yardages and Cutting

WOF is 42" width of fabric from selvage edge to selvage edge.

### 1-1/4 yards Floral Border print

- Fussy-cut (2) 10-1/2" x 40-1/2" side rectangles and (1) 14-1/2" x 40-1/2" center rectangle along the length of the fabric, in a continuous series: side - center - side, similar to the cover image.

### 2 yards Floral Stripe

- (2) rectangles 10-1/4" x 68" along length of fabric for outer side borders. Cut 1/4" from the blue stripe on the left edge and then 10-1/4" from the cut edge.
- (2) rectangles 10-1/4" x 64" along length of fabric for top and bottom outer borders cut in the same manner.



### 3/4 yard Black solid

- (6) strips 1-1/2" x WOF; sub-cut into:
  - (4) strips 1-1/2" x 40-1/2" and
  - (2) strips 1-1/2" x 38-1/2".
- (7) strips 2 1/4" x WOF for binding.

### 1/2 yard Yellow tonal

- (4) strips 1" x WOF; sub-cut into:
  - (2) strips 1" x 42-1/2" and
  - (2) strips 1" x 39-1/2".
- (7) strips 1" x WOF join the strips on the short ends with diagonal seams, then cut into (2) strips 1" x 63", and (2) strips 1" x 60".

### 4-1/2 yards of 42" backing fabric

- (2) pieces 80" x WOF OR

### 2-1/4 yards wide backing fabric

- (1) piece 76" x 80".

### Batting

- 1 piece 76" x 80".

## Completing the Quilt

*Use a 1/4" seam allowance for all stitching. Press all seams as directed. Refer to the exploded quilt diagram throughout the instruction steps.*

1. Sew a 1-1/2" x 40-1/2" black strip to both sides of the Center Floral Border rectangle. Then sew the Side Floral Border rectangles to the left and right sides, placing them to maintain the continuous floral scene. Next, sew a 1-1/2" x 40-1/2" black strip to both sides. Press seams toward center.



2. Sew a 1-1/2" x 38-1/2" black strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press seams toward the center.
3. Sew a 1" x 42-1/2" Yellow strip to the left and right sides of the quilt center. Then sew a 1" x 39-1/2" Yellow strip to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press seams toward the black strips.
4. Center and stitch a 10-1/4" x 68" Floral Stripe rectangle to the left and right sides of the quilt center, beginning, ending and securing 1/4" from the corners of the quilt center. Repeat with the 10-1/4" x 64" rectangles on the top and bottom. Miter corners using your favorite method, checking to be sure that the stripe matches and all corners lie flat. Trim mitered corner seams to 1/4" and press open to complete the quilt top. Press Floral Stripe seams toward the rectangles.
5. Sew a 1" x 63" Yellow strip to the left and right sides of the quilt center. Then sew a 1" x 60" Yellow strip to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press seams toward the Floral Stripe rectangles.
6. If using 42" backing fabric, remove the selvage edges from the backing pieces. Join the pieces on the long edges with a 1/2" seam allowance. Press seam open. Trim to make a 76" x 80" backing piece.
7. Layer the top with the backing and batting pieces. Quilt as desired. Trim batting and backing even with the top.
8. Join the black solid binding strips on the short ends with diagonal seams to make a long strip. Press seams in one direction. Press the strip in half along the length with wrong sides together.
9. Bind the quilt edges using your favorite method to complete the quilt.
