Bethlehem Quilt

Skill Level: Beginner

CUTTING

WOF = Width of Fabric

45280 EG – 1 panel, Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " outside the red frame around the Nativity image

45284 S – Cream Tonal-

Cut 3 strips @ $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF.

Sub cut into 24 blocks @ $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{7}{8}$ " square. Divide these diagonally to make 48 half square triangles (HST). Set aside remainder for backing.

45284 K-Green Tonal

Cut 6 strips @ $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF; join these together using diagonal seams, cut 2 strips @ $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x 65" and 2 strips @ $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x 54", (Border 3)

Cut 6 strips @ 5" x WOF; join these together using diagonal seams, cut 4 strips @ 5" x 45"

Cut 1 strip @ 5" x WOF; sub cut into 4 blocks @ 5" x 5" square. Trim the remaining strip to $3\frac{1}{2}$ " wide. From this strip, sub cut 4 blocks @ $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

45285 R – Red Tonal

Cut 8 strips @ $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF; join these together using diagonal seams, Cut 2 strips @ $79\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ ", 2 strips @ 63" x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " (Border 5)

Cut 3 strips @ 4" x WOF; join these together using diagonal seams. From this strip cut 2 strips 49" x 4". (Border 2)

Cut 3 strips @ $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF; Sub cut into 24 blocks $4\frac{7}{8}$ " square. Divide these diagonally to make 48 HST's.

45287 E –Tan Tonal

Cut 7 strips @ 5" x WOF. Join these together using diagonal seams. From this strip cut 2 strips @ $70\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5" and 2 strips 54" x 5"

Green Tonal - 45284 K- Binding

Cut 8 strips @ $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF; join these together using diagonal seams.

SEWING:

Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams and press seams to the darker fabric as you sew. This quilt is constructed starting with the center panel and adding strips outward.

Pieced Block border

1. Sew a Cream tonal half square triangle (HST) to a red tonal HST and repeat to make 48 HST units.



2. Sew 2 HST units together as shown to make 24 pairs of HST units.



3. Sew the pairs of HST units together to make 12 pinwheel blocks.

4. Sew 6 blocks together as shown below and repeat to make 2 pinwheel block strips and set aside for border 2 top and bottom.



Quilt top Assembly

1. Sew two 5" x 45" Green tonal strips to the sides of the panel. Press the seam towards the border. Trim the extra length off the Green tonal strip, even with the panel. Sew the other two 5" x 45" Green tonal strips to the top and bottom edges. Trim the extra length off the Green tonal strip, even with the last border. Measure the size of the panel including the border strips and trim it to measure $41\frac{1}{2}$ " x 49". Keep the image centered when trimming.

2. Sew the 4" x 49" red tonal strips to the side edges of the quilt top. Press the seams towards the red tonal border. Sew the pinwheel strips to the top and bottom edges of the quilt top. Press the seams towards the Green tonal border.

3. Sew the $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x 65" Green tonal strips to the side edges and sew the $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x 54" Green tonal strips to the top and bottom edges of the quilt top. Press the seams towards the Green tonal border

4. Sew the 5" x $70\frac{1}{2}$ " Tan Tonal strips to the side edges of the quilt top. Press the seam towards the Green tonal border. Sew a 5" Green tonal block to each short end of the two 5" x 54" Tan Tonal strips, press the seam towards the Green tonal square. Sew these to the top and bottom edges of the quilt top. Press the seam towards the Green tonal border

5. Sew the $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $79\frac{1}{2}$ " red Tonal strips to the side edges of the quilt top. Press the seam towards the Red tonal border Sew the $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Green tonal square to each end of the two $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 63" red Tonal strips, press the seam towards the Red tonal border. Sew these to the top and bottom edges of the quilt top. Press the seam towards the Red tonal border

6. Quilt and bind as desired.
