




Skill Level: Confident Beginner

Note: Unless noted, measurements are given in inches and seam allowance is $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Strips are cut selvedge to selvedge. **RST** = right sides together
WST = wrong sides together **WOF** = width of fabric

(1) 8" x 10" square paper backed fusible webbing

Cutting and Fabric Preparation:

1. 21988K Panel:

- Fussy cut the four large picture motifs from the panel $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12", centering the motif.
- Fussy cut the four Motto, Oath, Law and Slogan motifs $10\frac{1}{2}$ " wide by 5" high, again centering the motifs.
- Cut the BSA on point badge, the Boy Scout emblem badge, and the two circular badges along the printed edges.

2. 21990H Green Compass Print:

Cut (3) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

3. 21991R Red Badge Toile:

Cut (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

4. 21992J Multi Stripe:

Cut (2) 4" strips. Subcut (8) 4 " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.

Block Assembly:

- Sew (1) Multi Stripe $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the top and (1) Multi Stripe $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the bottom of the $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5" Motto motif. Press seams away from the center motif.
- Repeat Step #5 with the Oath, Law, and Slogan motifs, again pressing away from the center motifs.
- Fuse a fussy cut patch to the bottom of each of the blocks created in Steps #5 and #6, centering

the patch on the bottom rectangle, following the manufacturer's directions for fusing. To match the quilt as shown, fuse the Boy Scout emblem badge below the Slogan motif, the BSA on point badge below the Motto motif, the round Boy Scouts of America badge below the Law motif, and the round BSA badge below the Oath motif.

8. Using the finished quilt diagram as your guide, stitch a large $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x 13" motif to the right side of two of the blocks created in steps #5 - #7; press toward the large motif.

9. Using the finished quilt diagram as your guide, stitch the remaining two $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x 13" motifs to the left side of the remaining two blocks created in steps #5 - #7; press toward the large motif.

10. Using the finished quilt diagram as your guide, sew the four block sets together, alternating the large motif and slogan motifs. Press seams toward the bottom of the quilt.

11. Sew the (3) Green Compass Print $5\frac{1}{2}$ " strips together end to end, at a 45-degree angle. Cut (2) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x 51" strips.

12. Sew the (2) Green Compass Print $5\frac{1}{2}$ " strips to the left and right side of the quilt center created in step #10. Press toward the Green Compass Print strips. Trim excess even with quilt top and bottom edges.

Finish the Quilt:

13. Center and lay the batting on top of the wrong side of the backing fabric

14. Center and lay the pieced quilt top on top of the batting.

15. Pin or baste the quilt sandwich using your preferred method for securing the layers.

16. Quilt as desired.

17. Use the (4) Red Badge Toile $2\frac{1}{2}$ " binding strips to bind the quilt.
