





Skill Level: Advanced

Cutting

(All strips are cut across the width of the fabric from selvage edge to selvage edge.)

From the dog OR cat bed print, cut:

Cut (4) 6 1/2" strips for the middle border

From the basket weave print, cut:

Cut (6) 3 1/2" strips for the outer border.

Cut (4) 2 1/2" strips for the inner border.

From the cream paw print, cut:

Cut (2) 3 1/2" strips; Sub cut (16) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares (corner blocks)

From the blue paw print, cut:

Cut (1) 6 1/2" strip. Sub cut (4) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares. Trim remainder of strip to 3 1/2" wide and sub cut (4) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares.

Cut (3) 4 3/4" strips. Sub cut (24) 4 3/4" x 4 3/4" squares.

From the white bone OR white butterfly print, cut:

Cut (1) 7 1/4" strip; Sub cut (4) 7 1/4" x 7 1/4" squares, divide each square in half on both diagonals to yield total of (16) triangles

Cut (1) 6 7/8" strip; Sub cut (2) 6 7/8" x 6 7/8" squares, divide each square in half on one diagonal to yield total of (4) triangles

From the brown bone OR brown butterfly print, cut:

Cut (1) 9 3/4" strip; Sub cut (2) 9 3/4" x 9 3/4" squares, divide each square in half on both diagonals to yield total of (8) triangles

Cut (1) 5 5/8" strip; Sub cut (2) 5 5/8" x 5 5/8" squares, divide each square in half on both diagonals to yield total of (8) triangles. Trim remainder of strip to 5 1/8" and sub cut (4) 5 1/8" x 5 1/8" squares, divide each square in half on one diagonal to yield total of (8) triangles

Cut (6) 2 1/4" strips for the binding.

From the dog OR cat yellow gingham, cut:

Cut (1) 6 1/2" strip; sub cut (4) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares.

Cut (1) 4 3/4" strip; sub cut (8) 4 3/4" x 4 3/4" squares


From the dog OR cat faces print, cut:

Cut (1) 9" x 9" square so that the motif is on the diagonal, Stay stitch 1/8" all the way around the outer edge of each square to prevent stretching.


Sewing

(All seams are sewn with right sides together, raw edges even and using 1/4" seam allowance.)


1. Stitch 5 5/8" brown bone OR brown butterfly print triangles to adjacent sides of a 3 1/2" blue paw print square. Press the seams towards the triangles. Trim the long side of the unit leaving a 1/4" seam allowance below the corner of the blue square. Stitch this unit to a short side of a 9 3/4" brown triangle. See the image below. Press the seam towards the triangle.



2. Stitch a 9 3/4" brown print triangle to the right-hand side of 6 1/2" yellow gingham square. Matching center points, stitch the long sides of 5 1/8" brown triangles to the top and left side of the yellow square. Press the seams towards the triangles.



3. Stitch together (2) 4 3/4" blue paw print squares. Stitch a 6 7/8" white bone OR butterfly print triangle to one long side of the blue squares unit. Press the seam towards the triangle.




4. Stitch together the units made in steps 1-3 as shown to make (1) corner unit (13 1/4" x 9" unfinished).

5. Repeat steps 1-4 to make a total of (4) corner units noting the orientation of the 6 1/2" yellow gingham square in each unit.

Make the Side Units

6. Arrange (4) 4 ¾" blue paw print squares, (2) 4 ¾" yellow gingham squares, and (4) 7 ¼" white bone OR butterfly print triangles into (4) rows as shown, noting orientation of the yellow gingham squares. Stitch the units into rows and sew the rows together to make (1) side unit. Repeat to make total of (4) side units.




Quilt Assembly

(All seams are sewn with right sides together, raw edges even and using 1/4" seam allowance.)


7. Noting orientation of the yellow gingham squares in the corner units, stitch (2) corner units to opposite sides of the 9" face Print Square to make the center strip of the quilt top. Press the seams towards the center.



8. Noting orientation of the yellow gingham squares in the side units, stitch (2) side units to each long side of each of the (2) remaining corner units. Press the seams away from the center.



9. Stitch these units to the long sides of the unit made in step 7 to complete the quilt center.



10. Measure the quilt top through its center and cut two 2 ½" basket weave print strips this length. Sew these to opposite sides of the top. Measure top through its center again including the borders you just added. Cut two 2 ½" basket weave print strips this length and sew on remaining sides of quilt top. Press the seams towards the borders just added.

11. Measure the quilt top through its center and cut (4) 6 ½" dog OR cat bed print strips to this measurement. Stitch (2) lengths to the left and right sides of the quilt top. Press the seams towards the borders just added.

12. Draw diagonal lines on the wrong sides of (4) 3 ½" white paw print squares. Right sides together, layer (2) marked squares on opposite corners of a 6 ½" blue paw print square. Sew on the marked lines. Trim 1/4" beyond the seam lines and press the resulting white triangles away from the center. Repeat for the remaining corners of the blue square. Repeat to make a total of (4) blocks (6 ½" x 6 ½" unfinished).

13. Stitch the blocks made in step 12 to the short ends of the (2) remaining dog OR cat bed print strips from step 11. Sew the pieced borders to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press the seams towards the border strips.

14. Join the 3 ½" basket weave print strips using diagonal seams. Measure the length of the quilt top through its center and cut two 3 ½" basket weave strips to this measurement. Sew these to opposite sides of the top. Measure top across the center including the borders you just added. Cut two 3 ½" basket weave strips to this measurement and sew the top and bottom of the quilt. Press the seams towards the borders just added.

15. Layer the completed quilt top with batting and backing and quilt as desired. Bind the finished quilt using the 2 ¼" brown bone OR butterfly print strips.
