## General Information

- Skill Level: Confident Beginner
- Please read all instructions before beginning.
- All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam allowance.
- Pre-wash all fabrics and press with spray starch.  
***It is not recommended to pre-wash the Panel.***
- **WOF** = Width of Fabric is based on 40".
- Press all seams open (unless directed otherwise) to decrease bulk.
- Finished Blocks are 18" square.
- Label all pieces when cut for easier construction.

## Step 1: Cutting The Fabric

### 1. Fabric A: 24614 X

#### (Multi Christmas Picture Panel)

- Fussy cut (6) squares at 10 1/2" – Block A.

### 2. Fabric B: 24621 E (Flax HO,HO,HO)

- Cut (8) strips at 2" x **WOF** – Sub-cut into (24) 10 1/2" x 2" rectangles – Blocks A, B, and C.
- Cut (8) strips at 2" x **WOF** – Sub-cut into (24) 13 1/2" x 2" rectangles – Blocks A, B, and C.

### 3. Fabric C: 24621 B

#### (Blue HO, HO, HO)

- Cut (4) strips at 1 1/2" x **WOF** – Sub-cut into (12) 13 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangles – Block A.
- Cut (6) strips at 1 1/2" x **WOF** – Sub-cut into (12) 15 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangles – Block A.

### 4. Fabric D: 24619 E

#### (Buttercream Snowflakes Medallions)

- Cut (12) strips at 2" x **WOF** – Sub-cut into (24) 15 1/2" x 2" rectangles – Blocks A, B, and C.
- Cut (12) strips at 2" x **WOF** – Sub-cut into (24) 18 1/2" x 2" rectangles – Blocks A, B and C.

### 5. Fabric E: 24618 G

#### (Med Green Christmas Medallions)

- Cut (1) strip at 10 1/2" x **WOF** – Sub-cut into (3) 10 1/2" squares – Block B.

### 6. Fabric F: 24617 R

#### (Red Santa, Snowman & Reindeer)

- Cut (1) strip at 10 1/2" x **WOF** – Sub-cut into (3) 10 1/2" squares – Block C.



### 7. Fabric G: 24619 R

#### (Dark Red Snowflakes Medallions)

- Cut (4) strips at 1 ½" x **WOF** – Sub-cut into (12) 13 ½" x 1 ½" rectangles – Blocks B and C.
- Cut (6) strips at 1 ½" x **WOF** – Sub-cut into (12) 15 ½" x 1 ½" rectangles – Blocks B and C.
- Cut (7) strips at 1 ½" x **WOF** – Join all the strips at the 1 ½" edge then sub-cut into (2) 56 ½" x 1 ½" rectangles (Top and Bottom) and (2) 1 ½" x 72 ½" rectangle (Left and Right Sides) – Inner Border.
- Cut (9) strips at 2 ½" x **WOF** – Join all the strips at the 2 ½" edge – Binding.

### 8. Fabric H: 24620 H

#### (Lt Green Christmas Trees & Gingerbread Men)

- Cut (8) strips at 3 ¼" x **WOF** – Join all the strips at the 3 ¼" edge. Sub-cut into (2) 62" x 3 ¼" rectangles (Top and Bottom) and (2) 3 ¼" x 74 ½" rectangles (Left and Right Sides) – Outer Border.

**Batting:** 68" x 86"

### Step 2 – Sewing Block A

**Note:** Refer to the illustration of the Finished Block when sewing the block together.

9. Sew (1) Fabric B 2" x 10 ½" rectangle to the left and right sides of (1) Fabric A 10 ½" square, then sew (1) Fabric B 13 ½" x 2" rectangle to the top and bottom to measure 13 ½" square.
10. Sew (1) Fabric C 1 ½" x 13 ½" rectangle to the left and right sides of the square just sewn, then sew (1) Fabric C 15 ½" x 1 ½" rectangle to the top and bottom to measure 15 ½" square.
11. Sew (1) Fabric D 2" x 15 ½" rectangle to the left and right sides of the square just sewn, then sew (1) Fabric D 18 ½" x 2" rectangle to the top and bottom to finish the block at 18 ½" square.
12. Repeat Instructions 9 through 11 to make (5) more blocks for a total of (6) blocks – Label "Block A" and set aside for use later.

**Note:** The fabrics change in each block as illustrated on the cover and in the Block Layout



### Step 3 – Blocks B and C

**Note:** Refer to the illustration of the Block Layout when sewing the blocks together.

13. Repeat Instructions 9 through 11 except replace Fabric A with Fabric E and Fabric C with Fabric G – Make (3) of Block B – Label and set aside for use later.
14. Repeat Instructions 9 through 11 except replace Fabric A with Fabric F and Fabric C with Fabric G – Make (3) of Block C – Label and set aside for use later.

### Step 4 – Sewing the Quilt Center

15. Sew (3) Blocks together per row of which will measure 54 ½" x 18 ½" as follows and refer to the illustration of the Block Layout as a guide:
  - a. Row 1 (Top) – Block A, Block B, Block A
  - b. Row 2 – Block C, Block A, Block B
  - c. Row 3 – Block A, Block C, Block A
  - d. Row 4 (Bottom) – Block B, Block A, Block C
16. Sew the rows together at the 54 ½" edge to measure 54 ½" x 72 ½".

### Step 5 – Adding the Borders

17. Sew (1) Fabric G 1 ½" x 72 ½" rectangle to the left and right sides of the center, then sew (1) Fabric G 56 ½" x 1 ½" rectangle to the top and bottom to finish the Inner Border at 56 ½" x 74 ½".
18. Sew (1) Fabric H 3 ¼" x 74 ½" rectangle to the left and right sides, then sew (1) Fabric H 62" x 3 ¼" rectangle to the top and bottom to finish the quilt top at 62" x 80".

### Step 6 – Finishing the Quilt

19. Layer the backing, batting, and quilt top and quilt as desired.
20. Using Fabric G 2 ½" strips sew on the binding to finish the quilt.
